**2007 SOUTH AUSTRALIAN JUNIOR MASTERS**

(Under the auspices of and subject to the control of the SAGA Inc)

**To be played at ROYAL ADELAIDE GOLF CLUB**

**Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> & Friday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2007**

36 holes stroke play in groups of three, each day. Open to all junior boys who are members of Clubs affiliated with the SAGA or State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association, who are under the age of 18 years as at 11th January 2007. **Handicap Limit will be 8 and under.**

A two man team's event will be played in conjunction with the 72 holes championship for nominated Interstate Invitees and SAGA selected team.

**Gross and Net trophies will be presented and players will not be permitted to win more than one trophy.**

**Entries close Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2007 at 5.00pm.**

**CONDITIONS**

1. Entries must be made on this form and the fee must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise it cannot be accepted.
2. Entries close 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2007, with the Secretary SAGA, PO Box 356 Torrensville Plaza 5031 at 5.00pm. No entries by telephone will be accepted, but the Association reserves the right to accept entries after the closing time in special circumstances.
3. The Association shall have the power to vary these conditions and to decide any dispute or question arising as to the qualification of any entrant and may in its absolute discretion at any time and without assigning any reason therefore refuse any entry or declare any entrant ineligible to compete.
4. Entries will be restricted to 54 players by a ballot of the higher handicapped players.
5. It is obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R&A/USGA approved lists.
6. The use of a motorised buggy by a competitor or his caddy is prohibited. Motorised means an electric or motor driven vehicle which a player or caddy may sit or ride, whilst the appliance is in motion. Exceptions to this condition may be granted where a player suffers from a permanent disability that would preclude him from competing in the event without the use of a motorised vehicle. Details for such exemptions are available from the office. Penalty Stroke Play – 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred. Maximum per round 4 strokes.
7. Drug Testing: All competitors are subject to drug testing by the ASDA for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia's Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy or refusing to take a test may be disqualified.
8. The Junior Committee, Junior Co-ordinator and Executive Director of the SAGA will make all playing arrangements and will umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged not later than five minutes after the conclusion of play.
9. In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless otherwise determined, play shall continue over such holes as decided, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with others until a winner is determined. All other trophies will be determined by Countback.
10. Play will be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules of the club. Tee Off Times - Rule 6-3a provides: The players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at the starting point ready to play within 5 minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes.
11. Dress Rules: Players and their caddies must comply with the dress requirements of the host club. Non-compliance could see the player/ caddy not allowed to start or asked to leave the course. Tailored shorts with long socks permissible. **Short socks are permitted provided they are plain white or have a club logo only.**
12. Practice: Invited Interstate Teams Players only - Wednesday p.m.
13. A seeded draw will be made for the second 36 holes with leaders playing at the end of the field.
14. The SAGA Code of Conduct applies to all competitors.
15. This event is for Australian Junior Order of Merit official points.
