### **NATIONAL SQUAD SET SIGHTS ON INDOOROOPILLY**

After their success at last week's MFS Women's Australian Open, the Golf Australia National Squad is off to Indooroopilly for the 2007 Australian Women's Amateur Stroke Play Championship.

Six of the eight National Squad girls who completed at Royal Sydney made the cut in what was a truly remarkable achievement for our national game at an international level.

Seven of these girls will line up at Indooroopilly GC on February 12 to vie for the national women's stroke play title along with more than 75 of Australia's best amateurs.

After their performance at Royal Sydney last week, Golf Australia's National Elite Development Director Peter Knight could barely contain his pride and excitement for the girls.

"It was an absolute privilege to see the way our National Squad girls performed at the 2007 MFS Women's Australian Open," Knight said.

"We are always setting high expectations but it was beyond these expectations for six of the eight girls to make the cut."

"The entire squad showed promising form throughout and demonstrated maturity beyond their years. If this is the future of women's golf in Australia then we are certainly heading in the right direction."

The girls will be in action at Indooroopilly from February 12 with the winner receiving an exemption to play in the 2008 MFS Women's Australian Open.
