#### **1. Welcome**

Peter Van Wegen welcomed all attendees and noted apologies.

#### **2. Minutes of Meeting Held 27 March 2007**

Nick Green noted that Golf Australia is examining providing professional development opportunities to state junior golf deliverers. Golf Australia will also produce a national junior tournament calendar.

#### **5. Active After-school Communities (AASC) program**

Kate Simkovic joined the meeting and presented an overview of the AASC program. Each state Board representative will investigate opportunities to increase their involvement in the program.

#### **6. Vision 2018 Executive Summary**

Nick Green presented the design of the document and informed the group that clubs will be directed to the Golf Australia website to download a soft copy.

To aid distribution, the Chair will send an email to state presidents and ED's in order to provide initial awareness. Following this, each AJGAB state representative will present the document to their relevant Executive Directors, Presidents and Boards. A Golf Australia representative will be made available to attend this presentation if desired.
