The Aaron Baddeley International Junior Championship is now in its 7<sup>th</sup> year of international tournaments and has been invited back to China.

For the last 6 years, Aaron has hosted a world junior tournament in Fiji and China for the development of junior players. This year the tournament is again returning to Guangzhou, China. Golf Australia who host the Australian Open, and the Women's Australian Open have again extended an invitation to the winning boy and girl this year.

Our last tournament in China had 10 countries competing. This year we expect to have between 10 – 15 countries attending.

**The tournament is open to any player under the age of 19 years old who wishes to enter the 2007 ABIJC championship from anywhere in the world.**

**Any player may enter by filling out the attached entry form and we suggest making a booking with the recommended travel agent and travelling with your country's team.**

The Dragon Lake Golf Club is one of the best golf courses in China and was chosen at our last tournament to be the host of the Asian Games for golf in 2010.

China is opening up to the world and is a country with a great mystery. A visit to the Great Wall of China is a must with many other tourist places available.
