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Golf Australia Junior Golf Development Lottery 2007

Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions of entry. The Golf Australia Junior Golf Development Lottery (the Lottery) is only open to residents of Australia.
2. This Lottery is a fundraising project initiated by Golf Australia to raise money towards junior development projects around Australia.

4. The Promoter is Golf Australia.
5. Entry to the Lottery is automatic by purchase of a ticket of \$5.00 between September 01 2007 00:01 (AEST) and November 16 2007 23:59 (AEST).
6. The total number of tickets printed and circulated to golf clubs around Australia is 150,000 with an extra 7,500 bonus tickets available to booksellers on Golf Australia's receipt of a fully sold book see Item 10 below for details.
7. Total prize value, as at 01 September 2007 is valued at \$148,458.
8. Ticket booksellers must return all tickets, sold or unsold, to Golf Australia by last mail Friday 16 November 2007.
