CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

November 2nd - 3rd 2007

1. **THE EVENT:** The Aaron Baddeley International Junior Championship is played over 36 holes stroke play:
2. **CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE:** The Championship Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Championship with full power at any time, to alter or vary any of the conditions.
3. **ENTRIES:** Entries close 5.00 pm October 5th 2007 and limited to 90 players with the lowest handicap.
4. **ENTRY FEES:** An entry fee of \$55.00 must be attached to the entry form.
5. **BUS TRANSPORTATION:** If you require transportation to and from the airport a fee of \$28.00 must be attached to the entry form.
6. **AGE REQUIREMENT:** Entrants must be **under 19 years*** of age as at November 29th 2007.
7. **RULES:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient for all ABIJC events.
8. **BALL:** Competitors must use a ball which is named in the current R & A and / or USGA approved lists.
9. **MOTORISED TRANSPORT:** Competitors may not travel in or on any motorized vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Committee.
10. **MOBILE PHONES:** Mobile phones are prohibited during ABIJC events by players and caddies.
11. **BAD WEATHER:** The Championship Committee may in the event of bad weather or for any other reason either shorten tournament or appoint another day or days for completion of the event.
12. **DRAW AND STARTING TIME:** A draw will be made by the Championship Committee. The Committee has the power to amend the draw or substitute another player for any competitor who is not at the first tee at the time appointed to play. It may also alter the starting time for any player.
13. **CADDIES:** The tournament asks all players to have a caddie for the event but this is not mandatory.
14. **DRINKS ON COURSE:** It is suggested players carry their own drink container / water bottle.
15. **TROPHIES:** Winner and Runner up:
 - > Boys and Girls 18 years
 - > Boys and Girls 17 years
 - > Boys and Girls 16 years
 - > Boys and Girls 15 years
16. **INTERNATIONAL TOURNAMENT:** The leading 4 boys and the leading 2 girls from the Australian Final will be offered a position in the **ABC Learning Centres Team Australia** to represent Australia in the Aaron Baddeley International Junior Championship to be held in China. In the event of players in these categories not being available, players with the next best scores will be offered the position.
17. **SPECIAL EXEMPTIONS:** The Championship Committee may add any player to the field where a special exemption is considered appropriate.
18. **CITIZENSHIP:** All players that qualify at the Australian Final to play in International Championship in China must be an Australian citizen or a permanent resident holding permanent visa status to be eligible to represent Australia and be part of the ABC Learning Centres Team Australia. A copy of your permanent visa status will be required. However, this does not exclude any player from entering the International Championship.
19. **ENTRY FORM AND CONDITIONS:** These conditions form part of the entry form.
20. **PASSPORTS:** All players as described in condition 15 must have or be prepared to obtain a passport and visa.

Tour Greens Australia will give a synthetic putting green to a player who has not previously received a green in an ABIJC event, from the drawing of a name out of a hat at the Players Dinner to which the player must be present at the drawing.

* Tour Greens Australia conditions.
