Terms and Conditions

1. Information on how to enter and prizes form part of these conditions of entry.

5. The Promotion will be judged by a panel of judges selected by the Promoter. Judging will commence on **Monday December 3** at the promoters premises. Winners will be notified by email using contact details provided in their entry on Wednesday December 5.
