**Notes & Conditions**

**1. Eligibility**

Eligible players are male amateurs who have reached their 55<sup>th</sup> birthday before 4<sup>th</sup> June, 2008 and who's Australian Handicap does not exceed 27 at the time of entry.

**2. Championship Procedures**

2.1 The Championship shall be played over 54 holes of stroke-play, 18 holes on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup>, 18 holes on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> and 18 holes on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> June, 2008.

**2.2 Championship Trophies**

- Overall Gross                                ➢ Overall Nett
- Overall Gross Runner Up                ➢ Overall Nett Runner Up

*Additional Trophies (Gross & Nett)*

- Age Groups 55-59, 60-64, 65-69, 70 & Over.

Note: The awarding of trophies in each of the above Age Groups will depend on the entries received.

Please note participants are only eligible to win ONE trophy

**3. Championship Committee**

3.1 The Championship Committee shall comprise of members of the Match Committee of Golf NT Inc, persons appointed by this body and two representatives of the Host Club.

3.2 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any such decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.

3.3 The Championship Committee decision matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Protests must be in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

3.4 The decision of the Championship Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.

**4. Rules of Play**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.

**5. Entries**

5.1 Entries shall only be made on the Official Entry Form issued by the Host Club or a photocopy thereof.

5.2 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, and shall sign a declaration, contained in the entry form, to that effect.

**6. Draw and Starting Times**

6.1 A draw for each day's play shall be made and published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Championship Committee as provided in Rule 6-3a. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship, that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided by Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five (5) minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two (2) strokes instead of disqualification.

6.2 The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

**7. The Ball**

7.1 It is obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a golf ball which is named in the current Royal and Ancient and/or USGA Conforming Balls List.

7.2 Throughout a stipulated round the player is limited to use golf balls with identical markings, except that the player identification number may differ by number only, not by colour. Penalty: two (2) strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round is four (4) strokes.

**8. Practice**

Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> June, 2008 or by arrangement with the Alice Springs Golf Club.

**9. Dress Regulations**

All competitors must conform to the Alice Springs Golf Club Dress Rules.

**10 Motorised Vehicles and Mobile Phones**

10.1 The use of a motorised buggy is permitted. The vehicle used must comply with the clubs local policy and must be registered under a Motor Vehicles Act of an Australian State or Territory.

10.2 The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during play of any competition round is prohibited.

Serious breaches of etiquette may result in disqualification.

**11 Ties**

11.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee determines, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with others, until the winner is determined.

11.2 In the event a player cannot be contacted, the Championship will be awarded to the player on the Course.

11.3 All other events will be decided by the Australian Count back System.
