Further to our correspondence of 22nd August 2007 we are pleased to advise that the National Insurance project is progressing well. To date we have:

1. Created the working group and met with representation from –
 - a. State Associations (5 in attendance with open invitation to other States)
 - b. Golf Management Australia
 - c. An independent representative of clubs
 - d. An Insurance advisor
 - e. Golf Australia
2. Discussed and reviewed insurance within other sports
3. Agreed on a survey for clubs to provide feedback.

In relation to point 3, we now seek your club's input so we may access the current industry insurance coverage. To this end we seek the completion and return of the attached survey by 30th November 2007. To make it easier for you we have made this available on line at -

We ask that only one person from the club fills out the survey, most likely the Club Treasurer, Hon. Secretary or Manager, it is possible you may also need assistance from your Broker. Please have your various insurance policies on hand.

In past surveys (2002 & 2004) clubs have advised that public liability was the number one concern for the industry. Golf Australia and its Member State Associations seek to alleviate this concern and provide a minimum industry standard at an affordable rate.

Results of this survey will be advised early in 2008.
