



Championships and Competitions Committee – CHARTER

Golf Australia conducts and supports golf events for both women and men in Australia.

These events include:

- Amateur Championships [Open, Junior, Mid and Senior]
- Open Championships
- Interstate Teams Championships [Open, Junior and Colts]
- International Championships when held in Australia [e.g. World Amateur Team Championships, Trans Tasman, Four Nations, etc.]
- Order of Merit Championships [Open, Junior and Senior]
- and other events that from time to time may be endorsed

Objectives

The Championships and Competitions Committee (CCC) is the key provider of advice to the Board and management on policies in relation to the conduct of competitions for national championships and international events conducted by Golf Australia in Australia.

The CCC's main objective is to ensure Golf Australia fulfills its role in conducting quality national championships and tournament that promote the game of golf in Australia.

In addition the CCC aims to improve the operational and participatory effectiveness of these events and by being a forum for communications between administration and the greater golfing community.

Structure

- A Chairperson nominated from the Board
- Two additional Board Members
- Each State may nominate one representative. ie up to six (6)
- The Director of Championships
- The Board may nominate up to two other independent members
- Director of Elite Development – non voting
- The CCC shall meet two times per annum [preferably face to face]
- A quorum shall require the attendance of the Chairperson (or nominated representative), Director of Championships (or nominated representative) and a minimum of two (2) state representatives
- Other ad hoc meetings will be held when required
- Other sub-committees (e.g. National Seniors Advisory Group, High Performance Advisory Panel) will work with the CCC as required to allow effective interchange of information
- The positions of the Committee members will become vacant and be re-advertised every two years (except after 2008 where the positions of three members will become vacant and be re-advertised).

Responsibilities

The CCC will:

- Review Golf Australia policies and procedures for the conduct of National Championships (excluding the Australian Opens) and international golf events conducted in Australia, including:
 - National schedule of events
 - Conditions of competition
 - Location
- Report recommendations and decisions of all meetings to the Board.
- Take appropriate action to investigate and provide recommendations on all matters referred to it by the Board.
- Bring to the attention of the Board any matters it feels will improve the implementation of the objectives.
- Facilitate all relevant communication with Member Associations and Host Clubs
