TERMS & CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. No Astronauts were harmed in the production of this entry form.

- 2. All male and female Aussie golfers are welcome to enter whether you hold an official Golf Australia (herein noted as GA) or Golf Access Australia handicap (herein noted as GA) or Golf Access Australia handicap (herein noted as GAA) or not.

 3. Player's, partners and their guests are required to have a sensational time and are required to participate in the Championship in the true spirit of the game or you may be sent to your room!

 4. Only golfers holding official handicaps are eligible for individual Championship titles and the "Green Jacket" in their respective division eg: Open Women, Men's A, B or C grade. Non handicap competitors will play in their own event for their own title.

 5. Proof of handicap must be provided prior to play in your first round on Monday 25th August, 2008.

 6. If you do not hold a Golflink card, you must present a letter from your club handicapper along with their contact details and the phone number of the club where your handicap is held (no exceptions). Failure to verify your handicap prior to play will result in disqualification from the Championship and you will automatically play in the non-handicap division.

 7. No social golf club handicaps are permitted. Players without a handicap will be handicapped using the Double Perrier system by the match committee. It is a complex system from Japan, is accurate and will take the next two pages to explain. See the Tournament Director upon arrival if you have questions.
- 8. Individual championships will be played over 54 holes over three consecutive days with mens and ladies categories in each grade (pending on numbers). Play will be via a stroke event in A grade and a single stableford in B, C and women's divisions.

 9. The green jacket will be awarded to the overall winner in each division and no longer the player with the most points over all three days.
- 10. The non-handicap event will be played over 54 holes over three consecutive days in one division.

- 13. The use of mobile phones is strictly forbidden during play or near the tee grounds during competition. Any player found to be using a mobile phone during play will be immediately disqualified as per the rules of golf and the Tournament Director shall confiscate your phone and proceed to download expensive ring-tones.
- 15. Play may be alternated between AM and PM shotgun starts at the discretion of the match committee during rounds one and two. The final round is a seeded draw in grades off the 1st tee. Should players have a little sleep in on the morning of the final round the Tournament Director chooses not to see any scary body bits this year and shall happily let you continue your nap.
- 16. Lunch is included during rounds one, two and three only. Should you lose your lunch ticket it will not be replaced. If it is stolen and you can point out the varmint please report them to the Tournament Director so he/she can help wash up. Complaints of any nature can be made directly to the Head Chef of the venue and not to Event HQ (he or she is the one in the kitchen with the big scary knives).

 17. To be eligible to play in the Champion Social Golf Club Team Event, you must field a minimum of three players per team from the same social golf club. Team members must be bonafide members of the same club. Proof may be requested by the match committee. Clubs may enter as many teams as they wish eg: Palm Meadows A, Palm Meadows B, Palm Meadows C etc. The three best daily scores count overall. However, all four players will be awarded from the winning team. Players in each team must remain the same for the duration of the event. - 18. Handicap adjustments (reductions only) in accordance with the current Australian handicapping system will be made after each round. It is solely the player's responsibility to play off the correct valid handicap in each round. Players must check their handicaps prior to play in each round or the player will be disqualified if playing from an incorrect handicap during any round of the Championship.
- 20. In the event of wet weather, Event HQ must pass any charges onto players (if any) that may be incurred from each golfing venue. Every effort will be made to return monies where possible, however this will be entirely based on the fees incurred by Event HQ on the day (if any). This is the decision of each golfing venue and not of Event HQ.
- 22. Approximately \$10K in prizes will be awarded during the Championship in accordance with the Rules of Golf closely observing the rules of amateur status.
- 23. Daily presentations will take place at the commencement of the following day's play. There will be no daily presentations following golf. Results will be posted at registration on the following morning.
- 24. Registration for the Championship will take place at the Radisson Resort from 9am to 4pm on Sunday 24th August. You may register prior to play on the morning of round one at Royal Pines Resort.

- 25. Final round prizes, along with all major awards, will be presented at the gala presentation dinner on Wednesday 27th August at the Radisson Resort ballroom.
- 27. Prize winners are responsible for the collection of their prizes for all awards presented during the Championship from Palm Meadows pro shop. Prizes will be held for 30 days after the Championship and will be donated to charity after this time if not collected or sold on EBay to pay the grog bill!
- 28. There will be no playoffs in B, C or women's divisions. Should a playoff occur in the mens A grade division, players involved must be ready to take the course immediately a playoff is announced. If a player has departed the golf course boundary, the remaining player's will either be deemed the winner or shall commence play (no exceptions). Winners in other divisions will be decided using the countback system. The countback will be taken from the last round played, then the second, then the first, the last nine holes and so forth until a winner is declared.
- 29. Ladies divisions: A grade = 0 to 20, B grade = 21 to 30, C grade = 31 to 45. The divisions may be altered pending on number of entries without notice and at the match committee's discretion. A division may be deleted if an inadequate number of competitors in each division enter the Championship. Please note there is a maximum handicap for women of 45.
- 31. Players shall remain in the division in which they commence play on Monday 25th August 2008 for the duration of the Championship despite any increase or reductions in handicaps upon entering the event.
- 32. Defending champions will play in the division in which they commence play on Monday 25th August despite being in a different division than that won the previous year (if applicable)
- 34. The Championship will be conducted in accordance with the Rules of Golf in addition to local rules provided by Palm Meadows, Sanctuary Cove, Royal Pines Resort and Event HQ.
- 35. Entries close at 5pm Thursday 31st July, 2008 or when the field is full (whichever occurs first). Event HQ advises haste in registering to avoid disappointment.
- 36. The early bird discount closes at 3pm Monday 30th June, 2008. The discount only applies to those players who have paid all fees in FULL by this date. After this time the discount does not apply and full fees are required.
- 37. Entry fees do not include accommodation, airport or practice round transfers, travel insurance, airfares, any incidentals, food or beverage outside of that outlined in this brochure. It does include a fantastic time. All figures quoted are based on a per person basis in Australian dollars and inclusive of GST.
- 38. Should any player or partner miss their transfers, their onward or return journey will be at their own expense. No claim can be made or will be heard by Event HQ.

- 41. BYO beverages are not permitted on any golf course and will be confiscated by the Tournament Director and/or her representatives to be put to good use elsewhere mainly room # X.
- 42. A deposit of \$200 each for players and partners MUST accompany each completed entry form. No deposit = no reserved position in the Championship and no reserved accommodation.

- 45. Credit card payments will attract a 1% transaction fee (Visa and Mastercard). Diners Club, American Express or any other credit card is not accepted unless you are happy with a 3% transaction fee added to your entry fee. Cheques will attract a .90 cent transaction fee. Please keep in mind that these fees are charged by the NAB and NOT by choice of the Tournament Director, therefore any complaints can be directed to the NAB Customer Service Staff that will happily clarify this point for you. Event HQ strongly encourages players and their guests to use the electronic funds transfer (EFT) option where NO fees are incurred.
- 46. The ladies luncheon has been arranged for Tuesday 26th August at Conrad Jupiters Casino in Broadbeach. Transfers are included and are to and from the Radisson Resort only. Male players who bombed in round 1 and 2 are not permitted to dress up and join the ladies as per last year or face the consequences from the Tournament Director which will involve wearing your outfit at the gala presentation night.
- 47. Unless Event Headquarters has otherwise been notified or alternative arrangements have been made, the balance of payment will be automatically deducted from your nominated credit card at 5pm on Friday 1st August 2008.
- 48. Refund applications received in writing before 5pm Monday 30th June, 2008 will be subject to a \$100 administration charge.
- 49. Cancellation in writing after this date and before 9am Monday 11th August, 2008 will be subject to a 50% cancellation fee. Cancellation after this date (11.8.07) will be subject to a 75% cancellation fee plus 100% of the cost of accommodation.
- 50. No responsibility will be taken by Event HQ for any misdirected entry forms or deposits made via post. Proof of posting is not proof of receipt.

- 51. No responsibility will be taken by Event HQ for any misdirected payments or deposits made by EFT. If payment has been misdirected it is the player's responsibility to track down the lost payment and provide proof of the transaction.
- 52. No responsibility will be taken by Event HQ for any misdirected credit card details as all details and records are kept secure at all times
- 54. No golf courses partaking in the Championship are walking venues. Spectators are not permitted on any course. Electric carts are included in the entry fee and are compulsory. Drivers must hold a current Australian or International drivers licence otherwise you remain a passenger for the duration of the event.
- 55. Children are not permitted to attend the gala presentation evening. Attendees must be 18 years of age in observance of Queensland's liquor licensing laws. Should you require a baby sitter, simply advise Event HQ and we will assist with your arrangements if
- 56. Beverages included at each social function include standard Australian beer, wine, juice and soft drinks. Functions do not include spirits, but will be available for purchase.

- 59. The term "FORE" is to be used by a player or their group to warn any person/s on, near or surrounding the golf course boundary of a moving ball that may cause harm. If a person has been hit by a golf ball, golf club or any other part of a player's equipment that player is deemed responsible for any and all damages that may be incurred. Event HQ and its suppliers will not be held liable in any circumstances.
- 60. Damages or theft (if any) to any golf course (and/or but not limited to), electric carts, surrounding residential areas, entrances, transfer vehicles, the Radisson Resort, Event HQ property, car parks, garden beds and any other and all property is to be paid for by the individual/s responsible.
- 61. Event HQ reserves the right to refuse entry into the Championship, disqualify and/or remove any person/s from the premises/Championship in the event of anti social behaviour, verbal abuse toward staff or abuse of the RSA (Responsible Service of Alcohol) act without notice. Event HQ along with management of any venue participating in the event will solely determine what is and what is not anti social behaviour. No further correspondence will be entered

- 66. The match committee's decisions are final and no further correspondence will be entered into.
- 67. In the event of any disputes during play, please pull aside and wait for the marshal and/or the match committee to attend to your enquiry or play a second ball.
