AUSTRALIAN REPRESENTATIVES AND RECORDS

TOYOTA Junior Golf World Cup, supported by JAL is the world's only junior golf championship in which 16 national teams, winners of regional qualifiers held across 6 continents and participated by more than 60 national teams, compete for the world champion trophy.

This tournament is meant to encourage the players' patriotic spirit during the competition, while providing them with the opportunity to develop international friendship among the players themselves.

Teams consist of four boys (aged 18 years or under) and play 72 holes stroke play with the best three scores recorded.
