CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. Eligibility – Eligible players are male and female amateurs who have reached their 55th birthday by 30th July 2009 and whose Golf Australia Handicap does not exceed 27 for men and 36 for women at the time of entry.
2. The Grange Senior Amateur is a 36 hole stroke play event (18 holes on each day) and will be controlled by The Grange Golf Club Incorporated Match Committee which will make all playing arrangements and will umpire in case of a dispute or protest, which must be lodged in writing with the General Manager before 6:00pm on the day of play.
3. Play will be conducted in three divisions and the divisions will be divided equally upon receipt of entries. As a guide the divisions will be as follows:
A Grade – Handicap 0 - 10
B Grade: Handicap 11 - 16
C Grade: Handicap 17 - 27
4. Championship trophies will be awarded for the following:
Overall Gross Wine and Runner Up
Overall Nett Winner and Runner Up – A Grade, B Grade & C Grade
First 18 Holes Winner – Gross & Nett
Second 18 Holes Winner – Gross & Nett
Ball run down for good scores and Nearest The Pins
5. Competitors must start at the appointed time. Rule 6 (3) will apply.
6. The rules governing this event shall be the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland together with such local rules as enforced by The Grange Golf Club Incorporated.
7. In the event of a tie for the Gross Championship winner a sudden death play off will occur.
8. Competitors will be made honorary members of The Grange Golf Club Incorporated for the day of play.
9. The Grange Golf Club Incorporated reserves the right to limit the number of entries accepted.
10. All competitors must comply with The Grange Golf Club's dress regulations.
11. Motorised Vehicles & Mobile Phones
 - 11.1 The use of a motorised buggy is permitted.
 - 11.2 Subject to availability, preference will be given to players having a medical certificate.
 - 11.3 The use of mobile phones by players and/or caddies during play of any competition round is prohibited.
12. Entries close Thursday 30th July 2009 at 5:00pm – No late entries will be accepted.
13. Entry Fee must accompany entry form.
