### Registration:

Competitors are required to register between 12:00 pm and 3:00 pm on Sunday 26 October at Ulverstone Golf Club. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship. If it is impossible to register in person, competitors must contact the Championship Office on 0414 696 810 on registration day. Competitors are not required to register each day. Score cards, Local Rules and hole placement sheets will be distributed by the starter on the starting tee.

### Championship Welcome Cocktail Party & Presentation Drinks:

All players are invited to attend the Championship Welcome Cocktail Party (includes finger food & drinks) to be held on Monday 27 October at 6.30 pm at Ulverstone Golf Club. Dress for the Cocktail Party is smart casual. Presentation Drinks will be held on Friday 31 October at approximately 12.30 pm at Ulverstone Golf Club. Dress is smart casual or golfing attire.

### Practice:

A practice round is available on Sunday 26 October. Players must have teed off prior to 1.00 pm. There is no time sheet – players may tee off when they arrive at the course. Practice at other times is available, however please contact the club to ascertain a time. Ph: 03 6425 2322. Play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only – competitors only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

### Range Facilities and Balls:

A practice fairway is available and practice balls are available from the Pro Shop for \$5.00 per bucket. There is also a practice chipping and putting green.

**Pull Buggies:** Local competitors and those traveling by car are requested to use their own pull buggies. Any players requiring a motorised cart (medical certificate only), an electric buggy or a pull buggy **MUST** contact Golf Australia when they enter and advise of their requirements to enable extra hire buggies to be arranged.

### Club Storage:

Clubs made be stored at the club.

### Player Lockers:

Lockers are not available, however valuables may be locked in an office if required.

**Caddies:**

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddy they must make their own arrangements.

**Yardage Books:**

Yardage Books will not be produced, however a detailed description of each hole is available from the Ulverstone Golf Club website.

**Draw for Match Play Rounds:**

There will be 36-holes of stroke play to qualify 16 players for elimination match play in the Women's Senior Amateur Championship, and 8 players in each of the three Championship Flights. The Match Play Draws will be available from the Championship Office as soon as possible after the qualifying rounds.

**Ties:**

In the event of a tie after the qualifying rounds for the last places in the Championship Draw, the places will be determined by a sudden-death, hole-by-hole, play-off to be held immediately after the 2nd qualifying round has concluded on Wednesday 28 October, or, if necessary due to insufficient light, the next morning. Any competitor in the play-off not ready to play when called will be disqualified. Ties for the last available places in the Championships Flights will be decided by countback.

**Dress Requirements:**

"Soft" spikes are preferred at Ulverstone Golf Club but are not permitted in the clubhouse. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted.

**Catering:**

Catering will be available from the clubhouse from 10.00 am – 3.00 pm daily at the player's expense. Complimentary tea and coffee will be available from 7.00 am.

**Mobile Phones:**

Mobile phones may not be used on the golf courses during competition play under any circumstances. A COMPETITOR FAILING TO ADHERE TO THIS REGULATION WILL BE IN BREACH OF GOLF AUSTRALIA'S CODE OF CONDUCT.
