### **Registration:**

Competitors are required to register between 10:30am and 3:30pm on Sunday 7 October at Glenelg Golf Club. At this time, competitors will be required to provide their Golf Link number and a phone number where they can be contacted during the event. Players will also be asked to advise if they intend on attending the Welcome Cocktail Reception and Presentation Drinks and also if they will require the use of a pull buggy. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship.

If it is impossible to register in person, competitors must contact the Championship Office on registration day.

### **Championship Welcome Cocktail Party & Presentation Drinks:**

All players are invited to attend the Championship Welcome Cocktail Party (includes finger food & drinks) to be held on Tuesday 9 October at 6.00pm at Glenelg Golf Club. Dress for the Cocktail Party is smart casual.

Presentation Drinks will be held on Friday 12 October at approximately 5.00pm at Glenelg Golf Club. Dress is smart casual or golfing attire.

### **Practice:**

A practice round is available after 12.30pm on Sunday 7 October. Please contact Glenelg Pro Shop on 08 8295 5274 to make a reservation.

Play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only – competitors only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

### **Range Facilities and Balls:**

A practice fairway is available and competitors will receive complimentary practice balls on the Championships days. Practice balls are available from the Pro Shop. There is also a large practice chipping and putting green facility with two bunkers.

**Pull Buggies:**

Local competitors and those traveling by car are requested to use their own pull buggies. Glenelg Golf Club does have limited pull buggies available and competitors will be asked if they require the use of a pull buggy at Registration.

**Club Storage:**

There is limited club storage available at Glenelg Golf Club so players are requested to make alternate arrangements.

**Player Lockers:**

A small number of Lockers are available to competitors if required.

**Caddies:**

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddy they must make their own arrangements.

**Competition Conditions:**

Please refer to the Championship Conditions as listed on the entry form, particularly Condition Number 7 pertaining to Conforming Golf Balls, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting. Competitors are requested to report to the starter 15 minutes prior to the advertised starting time. Score cards, Local Rules and hole placement sheets will be distributed by the starter on their starting tee.

**Driving Clubs Condition – IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ!:**

The driver the player carries must have a clubhead, identified by model and loft, that is named on the current List of Conforming Driver Heads issued by R&A Rules Limited. Note: Any individual driver on the List, if tested on pendulum apparatus approved by R&A Rules Limited, must not have a characteristic time greater than 257 microseconds. Penalty: Disqualification

**Draw for Match Play Rounds:**

There will be 36-holes of stroke play to qualify 16 players for elimination match play in the Women's Senior Amateur Championship, and 8 players in each of the three Championship Flights. The Match Play Draws will be available from the Championship Office as soon as possible after the qualifying rounds.

**Results & Draws:**

All results and draws will be posted on the [Golf Australia website](http://www.golfaustralia.com.au).

**Ties:**

In the event of a tie after the qualifying rounds for the last places in the Championship Draw, the places will be determined by a sudden-death, hole-by-hole, play-off to be held immediately after the 2nd qualifying round has concluded on Wednesday 10 October, or, if necessary due to insufficient light, the next morning. Any competitor in the play-off not ready to play when called will be disqualified. Ties for the last available places in the Championships Flights will be decided by countback.

**Dress Requirements:**

"Hard" spikes are not permitted at Glenelg Golf Club. Soft spikes are permitted in the spike bar area only. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted.

**Catering:**

Lunch will be available in the Clubhouse for the duration of the event and tea and coffee will be available prior to play outside the Pro Shop.

**Mobile Phones:**

Mobile phones may not be used on the golf courses during competition play under any circumstances. A COMPETITOR FAILING TO ADHERE TO THIS REGULATION WILL BE IN BREACH OF GOLF AUSTRALIA'S CODE OF CONDUCT.
