History

The first Colts Interstate Match was played in 1993, when the junior age changed from under 21 years to under 18 years. To be eligible for a Colts Team, players must be aged between 18-23 years. The Colts Interstate Teams Matches are played in conjunction with the Men's Interstate Teams Matches.

Each team consists of six players, with all players taking part in three foursomes, and five players involved in the singles.

From 2007, the Women's, Men's and Colts Interstate Teams Matches were played concurrently in the same city.
