### Tournament Functions:

*Australian Men's Stroke Play Championship – Presentation Cocktail Party:*

Sunday 21 March at the conclusion of play – approximately 2.30 pm – 3.30 pm at Lake Karrinyup CC (Dress – smart casual)

*Australian Men's and Women's Amateur Championships – Presentation Cocktail Party:*

Wednesday 24 March at the conclusion of play – approximately 4.00 pm – 5.00 pm at Lake Karrinyup CC (Dress – golfing attire or casual (no jeans))

**Registration:**

Competitors are required to register between 12:00 pm and 3:30 pm on Wednesday 17 March at Lake Karrinyup Country Club. At this time, competitors will be required to provide a phone number where they can be contacted during the event. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship.

If it is impossible to register in person, competitors must contact the Championship Office on registration day on 0448 366 224.

**Withdrawals:**

If you are unable to compete, please contact Golf Australia immediately on 03 9626 5050.

**Results & Draws:**

All results and draws will be posted at [www.golfaustralia.org.au](http://www.golfaustralia.org.au). The draw for rounds 1 and 2 will be available after 4.00 pm on Wednesday 17 March. If players are traveling together and would like similar tee times, this must be advised to Golf Australia no later than **Sunday 28 February**. Requests after this time will not be accommodated.

**Practice:**

Due to the large number of players who will wish to have a practice round, play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only – competitors only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

Lake Karrinyup Country Club – from 8.00 am on Wednesday 17 March.

Mt Lawley Golf Club – from 7.00 am on Tuesday 16 March.

***Players must ring the pro shop to make a booking.***

Unfortunately there may not be sufficient time for all players to have an 18-hole practice round at both courses on the designated days. Practice outside of these times may be made by contacting the relevant club and a green fee may be charged.

Competitors must adhere to the following practice conditions, and there will be marshals on course monitoring this condition:

- Unlimited chipping and putting around greens
- No "flop" shots around greens (except in the normal play of a hole)
- One shot ONLY into each green.
- May play two balls from tees (other than par threes)
- May play two balls from greenside bunkers (NB players must not walk up bunker faces)
- Course staff to retain absolute right of way
- **At all times, players must keep up with the group in front**

**Course Guides:**

Yardage books/course guides will be available at each player's own cost. Lake Karrinyup CC books will be available to purchase from the Tournament Office on Wednesday 17 March; and Mt Lawley GC books will be available from the Pro Shop on Tuesday 16 March.

***NB. Distance Measuring devices are NOT permitted – players may use them for the practice round only.***

**Range Facilities and Balls:**

A practice fairway is available at both clubs and competitors will receive complimentary practice balls prior to their round on the Championships days only. Practice balls on the Practice Day or at the conclusion of a player's round are at the player's expense. Practice balls are available from the Pro Shop.

**Pull Buggies:**

Local competitors and those travelling by car are requested to use their own pull buggies. Golf Australia will endeavour to provide a buggy to all players who require one, however players are

encouraged to bring a light-weight bag in the case that a hire buggy is not available. Buggies will be complimentary for Championship Days only for those players who require them.

**Club Storage and Lockers:**

There are no club storage or locker facilities available at either club.

**Physiotherapist and Medical Centres:**

A list of physiotherapists and Medical Centres is available from the Tournament Office if required.

**Caddies:**

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddie they must make their own arrangements.

**Competition Conditions:**

Please refer to the Championship Conditions as listed on the entry form. Competitors are requested to report to the starter approximately 10 minutes prior to the advertised starting time. Score cards, Local Rules and hole placement sheets will be distributed by the starter on their starting tee.

**Ties:**

In the event of a tie for the Australian Men's Stroke Play Championship, players in such a tie will continue over such holes as the Championship Play Committee will decide in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole play-off until the winner is determined.

In the event of a tie for the last match play places (32 in total) after the Australian Men's Stroke Play Championship, a sudden-death, hole-by-hole, play-off will be held immediately after the 4th round has concluded, or, if necessary due to insufficient light, the next morning. Any competitor in the play-off not ready to play when called will be disqualified.

**Dress Requirements:**

"Hard/Metal" spikes are not permitted. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted. Ankle socks for men are NOT permitted at Lake Karrinyup Country Club. Players are reminded that they are guests of the clubs and failure to adhere to dress regulations may result in players being asked to change or purchase appropriate dress.

**Catering:**

Both clubs will have catering available from 10.00 am until 3.30 pm. All food and beverage for players for the duration of the event is at the player's expense.

**Bottled Water:**

Complimentary bottled water will be supplied to players on the Championship Days only, from on or near the starting tees. Players are requested not to abuse this privilege and to place empty bottles in rubbish bins.

**Mobile Phones:**

Mobile phones may not be used on the golf courses during competition play under any circumstances. They are permitted in the car park areas only. A COMPETITOR FAILING TO ADHERE TO THIS REGULATION WILL BE IN BREACH OF GOLF AUSTRALIA'S CODE OF CONDUCT.

**Golf Australia Hard Card:**

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

**Course Care:**

All clubs which host Golf Australia National Championships kindly give up their course to you for the duration of the event. The course must be left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed. Sand buckets are not used at Lake Karrinyup CC but players MUST "chop-in" their divots. Players MUST carry AND use a sand bucket at Mt Lawley GC. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.
