The 2010 Handa Australian Senior Open will be held at **Royal Perth Golf Club** from 19-21 November 2010.

This is an opportunity to go behind the scenes and play a key role in delivery of the tournament. As a volunteer you can nominate for a variety of roles including being inside the ropes caddying for the players, marshalling, scoring and other exciting opportunities.

The tournament will consist of 3 rounds of 18 holes. After the first 2 rounds (Friday and Saturday), the field will be cut to the top 60 professionals (plus ties) for the final round.

Volunteers will be required in a number of areas during the tournament. You must be available to work a shift of FOUR to SIX HOURS on any **OR** all three tournament days.

Shifts may commence as early as 7:00am and finish as late as 6:00pm.

Volunteers will be provided with a shirt, a cap, lunch and drinks.

PREFERENCE	ROLE	DESCRIPTION
	Caddy	You will be allocated to a competitor to caddy for them for the duration of the tournament (including practice rounds, Pro-Am and all 3 tournament days). MUST be available to commence on Tuesday 16 th November through to Sunday 21 st November. Experience preferred. Pull buggies allowed.
	Carry Boards	Walk 18 holes with a playing group, displaying each player's score on a carry board.
	Marshall	Marshal crowds around the Clubhouse and in key areas on the golf course OR walk 18 holes with a playing group, assisting with spotting and marshalling the gallery.
	Leaderboards	Be stationed on one of the 3 main leaderboards around the golf course collecting scores via radio and updating the board (teams of 2 or 3 people will be on each board).
	Walking Scorer	Walk with a playing group, record each player's score and forward those scores through to Scoring Central after each hole. You need to be able to operate a two-way radio.
