CONDITIONS

1. Format

- 1.1 The Girls' Championships will be played in two separate sections.
- 1.2 (i) The first section will be decided by stroke play over two qualifying rounds. Each player will play two rounds at Tea Tree Gully Golf Club.
- 1.3 The winner of the first section of the Girls' Championship will be the 1st Qualifier.
- 1.4 After the first section of the Girls' Championship, the four (4) lowest scores will compete in the second section of the Girls' Championship.
- 1.5 In the event of there being a tie for a position after the first section of the girls' Championship such that more than 4 players remain in the Championship, those players tying for the last qualifying position or positions will continue over such holes as the Championship Match Committee determines in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole play-off until the 4 qualifiers for the second section of that Championship have been determined. However, if the Championship Match Committee determines that there is not sufficient time available for a play-off, such a tie will be resolved by lot. All other positions by countback.
- 1.6 The second section of the Girls' Championship will be played at The Vines of Reynella Golf Club and consist of successive rounds of match play, with losers being eliminated and winners progressing to the next round. The automatic draw will be applied to establish the match pairings.
- 1.7 In the event of a halved match in any round players will continue to play until a winner is determined.
- 1.8. The winner of the Girls' Championship will be the *SA Junior Amateur Champion* and hold the Junior Amateur Championship Cup for one year.
- 1.9 The Junior Girls B Grade Cup will follow the same format as the Girls' Championship.

2. Match Committee

- 2.1 The Match Committee will comprise the Golf SA Match Committee.
- 2.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 2.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 2.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final.
- 2.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

3. Rules of Play

- 3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.
- 3.2 Only Juniors may caddie for players in the match play.

4. Entries

- 4.1 Eligible players are junior girl Amateur Golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with GOLF SA or State or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association and who satisfy the necessary handicap and age qualifications.

- 4.2 The Entrance Fee for the Championship is \$20.00 (including GST), and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 4.3 Entries must be made on the entry form issued by Golf SA, or a facsimile copy thereof. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form. Entries by phone not accepted.
- 4.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 4.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 4.6 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by Golf SA prior to 5:00pm on Monday 3rd January 2011. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEIR ENTRY IS RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES.

5. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting

- 5.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, One Ball Condition and Time of Starting.

6. Drug Testing

- 6.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

7. Mobile Phones

- 7.1 Mobile phones must be switched off when on the golf course and may only be used in an emergency.

8. Pace of Play

- 8.1 Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered to be out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

9. Motorised Transport

- 9.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player's Club and by permission of the venue Club. Application and approvals to be forwarded with entry form. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

10. Code of Conduct

- 10.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf SA's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golfsa.com.au

11. Measuring Devices

- 11.1 For all play, a player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only.

12. Draws

- 12.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf SA website www.golfsa.com.au from Thursday 6th January 2011.
