CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



1. Eligibility

- 1.1 Any amateur male golfer who has attained the age of fifty five on the Twenty-third day of March 2011.
- 1.2 Each competitor must be a member of a club affiliated with Golf WA and hold a current Australian handicap. Eastern States competitors must be a member of a club affiliated with the applicable state body and hold a current Australian handicap. Overseas entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.

2. The event will be played in two sections.

2.1 The Championship

The Championship will be played over 54 holes of stroke play over consecutive days and is open to any player eligible by way of 1.2 above. The first round will be played on Wednesday, March 23 (am). The second round will be played on Thursday, March 24 (pm) and the final round on Friday, March 25 (am). The winner of the Championship will be the player who records the lowest fifty four hole gross total.

In the event of a tie for the winner a sudden death play off will occur.

In the event of a tie for the leading Western Australian player a sudden death play off will occur. In the case of other ties the Australian Countback System will be used.

2.2 "A" Grade and "B" Grade

"A" Grade and "B" Grade will be played over 36 holes of stroke play over consecutive days and is open to any player eligible by way of 1.2 above. The first round will be played on Wednesday, March 23 (am) and the second and final round will be played on Thursday, March 24 (pm).

Divisions "A" and "B" Grade will be divided equally upon receipt of entries. As a guide the divisions will be as follows –

"A" Grade Handicap 0 - 16 "B" Grade Handicap 17 - 36

In the case of ties the Australian Countback System will be used.

3. Trophies

- 3.1 Trophies will be awarded as followings –

Overall Gross Winner and Runner up The Championship, "A" Grade and "B" Grade

Overall Nett Winner and Runner up The Championship, "A" Grade and "B" Grade

- 3.2 The leading Western Australian player will represent Western Australia and be paid expenses to play in the 2011 Australian Amateur Seniors Championship at Tanunda Golf Club, Adelaide from May 3 to 5.

Should the state winner be unable to participate then the runner up will play in his place.

4. Field Size

The overall field size will be restricted to ninety six players. Should entries exceed this number then the highest handicapped players will be balloted.

5. Motorised Golf Carts

The Golf WA motorised golf carts policy will apply. Copies of this are available from clubs, the Golf WA Office or on the website <http://www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/motorisedcarts.mhtml>. Note— there are limited numbers of Motorised golf carts available for hire at Mandurah Country Club. Personal carts are permitted.

6. Time of Starting (Note to Rule 6-3a)

If the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, in the absence of circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.

7. Player Code of Conduct

All entrants assent to be bound by the Golf WA Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at <http://www.golfwa.org.au/guests/about/policies/codesofconduct.mhtml>

8. The Championship Committee

8.1 The Championship Committee will consist of the Chairperson of the Golf WA Golf Management Committee, members of the Golf Management Committee, the Golf Operations Manager together with any members of the host club that may be co-opted to serve on the Championship Committee.

8.2 The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any of the Championship Conditions.

8.3 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

9. Golf Balls

It will be obligatory for all competitors to play with a ball which is named in the current R and A and/or USGA List of Conforming Golf Balls.

10. Practice

Practice is limited to **one round by arrangement** with the Pro Shop (9535 5488) on Monday, March 21 (after 1.30 pm) or Tuesday, March 22 (after 1.00 pm)
