PLAYER INFORMATION

Registration

There will be Match officials on course on each day of play please register with them. Have your Golflink number and current correct handicap available for each days play. The 2011 Summer Meeting sees the use of one and two tee starts, as well as shot gun starts. Please take particular note of your tee time and which tee you are commencing from. Ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register. Registration must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time.

Scorecard return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated 'scorecard return area' in the clubhouse. Scores will be posted in the Clubhouse.

Use of motorised carts

Any player may use a motorised cart for any day in the event. Golf NSW accepts no responsibility for the availability of carts.

A player's use of a cart will not be permitted to affect the draw.

Dress Regulations

All entrants must comply with the Host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

Presentation

Presentations of prizes for the first 3 days of play will be conducted at Bowral Golf Club at the completion of play on Wednesday 9 March 2011. All players are encouraged to attend.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 140 of the Rules of Golf 2008-2011 in place.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship.

Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.

COURSE AND PARKING

BOWRAL GOLF CLUB:

On Monday there is a 2 tee start from the 1st and 10th tees, for access to the 10th tee there is an entry gate at the 8th tee from Burradoo Road.

On Wednesday and Thursday there is a shot-gun start, you can access the 5th, 6th, 8th, 13th, 16th and 17th tees via the entry gates on Links Road and Burradoo Road.

Please ensure you register and collect your scorecard from Golf NSW Official located at the Bowral Clubhouse before proceeding to the tee.

HIGHLANDS GOLF CLUB:

On Monday and Tuesday there is a single tee start, parking is available near the Pro shop and Clubhouse.

On Thursday there is a shot gun start. An entry gate and small car park is provided for players starting on holes 3rd, 6th, 7th, 8th, 9th and 11th tees. It is located on the Old Hume Hwy., past the Highlands Clubhouse, on the left, heading north, sign posted 'Willow Vale'.

Please ensure you register and collect your scorecard from the Golf NSW Official located near the Highlands Pro shop before proceeding to the tee.

MT BROUGHTON GOLF CLUB:

On Tuesday there is a 2 tee start from the 1st and 10th tees, there is ample parking available adjacent to the Pro shop.

On Wednesday there is a shot gun start, all players are required to register and make their way promptly to their allocated tee.

Registration on both days will be located near the Pro shop.

MOSS VALE GOLF CLUB:

On Monday and Tuesday there is a single tee start. There are course renovations taking place on the 1st and 4th holes only, Moss Vale is still playing as an 18 hole golf course, the renovations do not affect play. Parking is available near the Clubhouse.

On Thursday there is a shot gun start, all players are required to register and make their way promptly to their allocated tee.

Registration on both days will be located near the Pro shop.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

The Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events (at the time of the event) and the Golf NSW Code of Conduct apply to this Event where indicated.

Where there is any inconsistency between the conditions set out in the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and those set out for this Event, the conditions for this Event will prevail.

A copy of the Golf NSW Standard Conditions and Golf NSW Code of Conduct is available from the Golf NSW website at www.golfnsw.org and will be displayed at the Host Club(s) and will be available on request.

A: CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

1. The Championship Committee shall comprise the General Manager – Golf, Chairman of the Women’s Match Committee, Chairman of the Rules & Amateur Status Committee, or their nominees and such other members as determined by the Women’s Match Committee.
2. All entries are subject to the approval of the Championship Committee which reserves the right to accept or refuse any entry without giving reason for its decision which will be final.
3. Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day’s play. The Championship Committee’s decision on matters affecting the event shall be final.
4. The Championship Committee reserves the right to amend these Conditions.

B: GENERAL

1. This Event will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.
2. The Women’s Summer Meeting will be as outlined in the FORMAT. All ties to be determined using the Golf Australia Countback method. Players will be allocated to a division based upon their handicaps at time of entry.
3. **Reductions/Increases in Handicap before close of entries:** It is requested, that if a player reduces or increases her handicap by more than 2 strokes after forwarding her entry and before the closing date, she contact Golf NSW so that she is drawn in the correct Division. If a player reduces or increases her handicap after the closing date for entries, she will remain in the Division in which she has been drawn for the duration of the Tournament and compete on her current handicap.
4. **No reductions or increases in handicap will be made during the Tournament.** Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play. Scores for handicapping will be returned to the players’ clubs for processing after the last day of play. Number of Divisions, Courses to be used, Program and Handicap Limits for each Division will be determined after close of entries. In the event of a partner in the Foursomes Event, or a Team Member in the Teams Event, being unable to compete, a substitute will be accepted. No additional fee is payable, provided an Entry Fee for that event has been paid by the original player.
5. **Limit of Trophies:** Trophies will be limited to one 36 Hole Trophy for the Tournament and one 18 Hole Trophy per day. For the Singles event, Scratch will take precedence over Nett, and the order of precedence for 36 Hole Trophies will be as follows: 1. Winner – Scratch; 2. Runner-up – Scratch; 3. Winner – Nett; 4. Runner-up – Nett; 5. 3rd Scratch; 6. 3rd Nett. For Foursomes, the Trophies will be limited to one 18 Hole prize per pair, with Nett taking precedence over Scratch, in the following order: 1. Winner – Nett; Winner – Scratch; 2nd Nett and so on.
6. *Conforming Golf Balls, Driving Clubs and Starting Times:* The specimen condition in the Rules of Golf (2008-2011) are in effect as regards to Conforming Golf Balls (see page 142), Driving Clubs (Page 141) and Time of Starting (see page 143).
7. *Use of Motorised Transport:* Is permitted in this event. Golf NSW accepts no responsibility for the availability of carts. Players must make their own arrangements to reserve a cart at the course.
8. *Pace of Play:* Pace of play policy guidelines **will be laid down and strictly enforced** (see note 2; Rule 6-7). Penalties will be issued to individuals in groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to the application of penalties.
9. *Mobile Phone:* The Mobile Phone condition as outlined in the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events applies to this Championship.
10. *Distance Measuring Devices:* The specimen Local Rule on page 140 of the Rules of Golf 2008-2011 permitting their use applies for all play during these Events.
11. *Consumption of Alcohol:* The Consumption of Alcohol condition as outlined in the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events applies to these Events.
12. *Drug Testing:* All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in the Golf Australia’s Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this condition, or refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.
13. *NSW Code of Conduct:* The Golf NSW Code of Conduct applies to all players participating in this Event.
14. Entrants shall comply with the by-laws, rules and dress regulations of the Host Club(s). Players not complying with such regulations will not be permitted to start their round.

C: ENTRIES

1. The Women's Summer Meeting is open to Open to amateur women who hold a current Golf Australia Handicap or who hold a current official handicap in an overseas country. The entry fee is \$30.00 (including GST) per day or \$90.00 (including GST) for four days.
2. Entries must be made on the attached Entry Form or a facsimile copy thereof. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
3. The Entry Form (by post or by facsimile with credit card details) and relevant entry fee must be received at the Golf NSW Offices (PO Box 195 Arncliffe NSW 2205 or 50 Princes Highway Arncliffe NSW 2205) by the closing date for entries.
4. Postal or faxed entries must be accompanied by a copy of the entrant's current handicap record for the previous six months, officially endorsed by entrant's Club, unless the entrant has provided his GOLF Link number on the Entry Form.
5. Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Ltd, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and shall sign a declaration to that effect contained on the Entry Form or agree to such conditions through the online entry process.
6. In the event of an entrant being suspended by an affiliated club, a club affiliated with a District Golf Association, a District Golf Association on a golf related matter the entrant shall not be eligible to enter the event, even if she nominates another club as her home club for handicap purposes.
7. In the event of entrants exceeding the number of places available in the event, entries from those higher handicap competitors shall be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful entrants shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants balloted out, who do not subsequently compete.
8. A substitute eligible player will be permitted without the payment of an additional entry fee.
9. Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal prior to the closing date for entries or after the close of entries for medical reasons (a medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds). All refunds will be subject to a \$10.00 administration fee (includes GST).
10. Late entries may be accepted after the closing date at the discretion of the Match Committee. Any such entry shall be subject to \$20.00 late fee (includes GST).

D: REGISTRATION

1. Competitors should register 30 minutes prior to their allotted tee time at the Host Club.

E: PRACTICE

Practice rounds prior to the event are at the discretion of the host club. Permission must be sought from the host and practice times may be booked directly with the Professional Shop.

F: PRIZES

1. NSW Women's Summer Meeting – also refer to FORMAT AND TROPHIES
Division 1 and Division 2 - Trophies and Prizes will be awarded to scratch winner. Scratch and net prizes will be awarded for the singles event.
Division 3 – Trophy and Prizes will be awarded to the stableford winner.
The Foursomes - Prizes will be awarded in divisions
The Teams - Prizes will be awarded over the field at each course
2. **Ties:** In the event of a Tie in the Summer Cup or the Kathleen Armstrong Bowl, such players will be declared Joint Winners. All other ties shall be decided by the Golf Australia method of Countback (Matching Scores).

G: DATABASE OF ENTRANT'S DETAILS

1. The personal data contained in this Entry Form is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means.
2. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-news, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by golf clubs affiliated with the Golf NSW or golf clubs affiliated with a NSW District Golf Association. Upon receipt by Golf NSW of a written request a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
