PRACTISE ROUNDS

The Lakes will have limited times available on the afternoon of Sunday 15th May from approximately 2:00pm. There is no cost to players for green fees, and play of the golf course is for official competitors only. Competitors should contact Christian at The Lakes office on (02) 9669 1311 for availability.

The Australian has the following times available for practise:

- Monday 16 May – After 12:00 noon.
- Tuesday 17 May – Play is not permitted between 12:00 – 1:00pm. All other times during that day will be fine.
- Wednesday 18 May – No play at all.
- Thursday 19 May - Play is not permitted between 12:00 – 1:00pm. All other times during that day will be fine.
- Friday 20 May – No play between 7:00am –10:00am and between 12:00 – 1:00pm Members only Time.
- Saturday 21 May – No play at all.

Players requesting practice times must contact the golf shop on 9663 2515 to book at suitable time - no player can just walk onto the course without prior notice. Please also note that all players must adhere to the Australian Golf Club dress standards, a copy of which has been emailed to every player.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated area in the clubhouse. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Qualification for Match Play

All those that qualify for Match Play will be listed online at www.golfnsw.org. All match play draws will also be available online at the completion of play on Friday 20 May.

Rules officials

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food and beverage

Breakfast will be available daily at The Lakes Golf Club. Standard lunch options will be available at both The Lakes and The Australian Golf Club's.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Dress Regulations

All entrants must comply with the host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

Presentation

Presentations will be conducted at the completion of play on Tuesday 17 and Friday 20 May at The Lakes Golf Club. The final presentation will be at The Australian Golf Club at the completion of play on Tuesday 24 May. If you are able to attend these, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 140 of the Rules of Golf 2008-2011 in place.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship.

Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.

CONDITIONS

2011 NSW Women's 72 Hole Stroke Play and Amateur Championship - CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Championship Procedure

1.1 The 72-hole Stroke Play Championship will be played over 72 holes of stroke play at The Lakes Golf Club. Round 1 – Monday 16 May, Round 2 – Tuesday 17 May, Round 3 – Thursday 19 May, Round 4 – Friday 20 May

Other Perpetual Trophies played in conjunction:

Leo Wray Bowl – 72 holes net, played in conjunction with 72 Holes Stroke Play.

Country Championship Cup – played in conjunction with first 36 holes of 72 Holes Stroke Play, best 36 hole scratch score recorded by a player whose Home Club is in Country NSW.

Metropolitan Championship – played in conjunction with first 36 holes of 72 Holes Stroke Play, best 36 hole scratch score recorded by a player whose Home Club is in Metropolitan NSW.

Silver Basket – played in conjunction with 72 Holes Stroke Play, best scratch score.

Mid Amateur Championship – played in conjunction with first 36 holes of 72 Hole Stroke Play, best 36 holes scratch score, by a player aged 30-54 years as at the first day of play.

The Margery McWilliam Bowl qualifying will be played over 36 Holes of stroke play at The Lakes Golf Club. Round 1 – Monday 16 May, Round 2 - Tuesday 17 May.

Match Play (as detailed in Program of Events) – the leading 16 scratch scores in the 72 Hole Stroke Play, who have nominated for the match play, will compete for the **NSW Amateur Championship**, with each match consisting of 18 holes, or as many holes are required to achieve a result, except the Final, which shall be of 36 holes, or as many holes are required to achieve a result.

The **NSWLGU Salver** shall be played for by players with the next best 8 scratch scores (from players on handicaps 6-14) with all matches consisting of 18 holes, or as many holes are required to achieve a result.

The **Margery McWilliam Bowl** - the leading 8 scratch scores in the 36 Hole Stroke Play who have nominated for the match play, will compete for the Margery McWilliam Bowl, with each match consisting of 18 holes, or as many holes are required to achieve a result

1.2 Ties: In the event of a Tie in the 72 Holes Stroke Play Championship, Mid Amateur Championship, Metropolitan and Country Championships, such players will be declared joint winners. Ties for qualifying positions in the State Championship, the NSWLGU Salver and the Margery McWilliam Bowl shall be decided by the Golf Australia method of Countback (matching scores). In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position in the State Championship, a sudden death play-off will be held over such holes as are determined by the Championship Committee until the last qualifier has been determined. Ties in all other events held in conjunction will be decided by the Golf Australia Method of Countback.

1.3 18, 36 and 72-hole scratch and nett trophies will be awarded at the completion of the Stroke Play, with a limit of one 18 hole trophy for each player per day (awarded in order of value).

1.4 Presentation of Trophies: Mid Amateur, Club Champion of Champions, Metropolitan and Country Championships at the Lakes Golf Club at close of play on Tuesday 17 May. 36-hole Qualifying for Margery McWilliam Bowl and Club Champion of Champions at The Lakes Golf club at the close of play on Tuesday 17 May. 72-hole Stroke Play, Leo Wray Bowl, Silver Basket – at The Lakes Golf Club at close of play on Friday 20 May NSW Amateur Match Play, NSWLGU Salver and Margery McWilliam Bowl– at close of play at The Australian Golf Club on 24 May.

2. Championship Play Committee

2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Women's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.

2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

2.3 The Championship Play Committee will have the sole management and control of the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.

2.4 The Championship Play Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

4. Entries

4.1 Eligible players are female amateurs whose Australian Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 14.4 strokes for the Championship, or are between 14.5 and 28.4 strokes for the Margery McWilliam Bowl, at the time of entry or who are an exempt player as detailed in Condition 5. Eligible players in the Club Champions Championship must be the current Club Champion at their Club. Eligible players in the Mid Amateur Championship must be aged 30-54 years as at the first day of play.

4.2 The Entry Fee is \$100 (Championship), \$60 (Margery McWilliam Bowl), \$50 (Club Champion of Champions or Mid Amateur only)

4.3 Entries must be made via the Golf NSW website, entry form issued by Golf NSW, or a facsimile copy thereof. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form.

4.4 Any player who has entered the Championship or Bowl on a correct handicap and whose handicap increases or decreases beyond the handicap limit for the event after the close of entries will be permitted to play in the event originally entered on their current handicap on first day of play. Should their handicap change prior to close of entries they must immediately advise Golf NSW.

4.5 Players will compete for the duration of the Championship on the handicap current on the first day of play (exception: see Condition 4.4).

4.6 The decision of the Championship Play Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.

4.7 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited.

4.8 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by Golf NSW prior to 5.00 pm Friday 29 April 2011. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT TO ENSURE THAT THE ENTRY IS RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES. A player's entry form has not officially been received until their name has been posted at www.golfnsw.org.

4.9 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, applications from those higher handicap competitors not exempt from a handicap ballot as detailed in Condition 5 will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.

4.10 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Play Committee and will incur a \$20 late fee.

4.11 Acceptable payment methods are only as follows – credit card (Visa or MasterCard only), cheque (personal or bank), money order, cash (please note that Golf NSW will NOT accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received). Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to Golf NSW.

4.12 Only entry forms accompanied by credit card payment will be accepted by facsimile or email. Entry forms accompanied by other acceptable payment methods must be submitted by post or in person. Entries will not be accepted by telephone. Entry forms will not be accepted unless they are fully completed.

4.13 Entrance Fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries, except for those entrants who fail to secure a place, or after the close of entries for medical reasons (a medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds). All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee.

4.14 Entrants and their caddie must abide by the dress regulations of the host club.

5. Exemptions

5.1 There are no exemptions for this Championship.

6. Television and Media

All rights for televising live, television recordings or for any visual or electronic reproduction of the Championship are reserved only to Golf NSW and may only be made under licence.

7. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting.

8. Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing [as](#) outlined in the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

9. Code of Conduct and Exclusion of Liability

All entrants are bound by Golf NSW' Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at www.golfnsw.org. Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or Golf Australia for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or Golf Australia codes of conduct and/or other related matters.

All entrants are aware that, as with any sporting event, there is a risk of suffering personal injury as a result of participation in this event. Entrants agree that, in consideration of being permitted to participate in this event by Golf NSW, that they will not hold Golf NSW, or its employees, servants or agents, liable for personal injury however caused whether due to any act of negligence, breach of duty, default or omission on the part of Golf NSW, or its employees, servants or agents or otherwise.

10. Motorised Transport

The Golf NSW Standard Condition is in effect. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Match Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry.

Note i: Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

11. Practice

To be arranged with host club Professional Shops.

12. Registration

Competitors are to register 30 mins before their starting time. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the Championship.

13. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

14. Database of Competitors' Details

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by Golf NSW-approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf NSW of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

15. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout the NSW Women's Stroke Play and Amateur Championships.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
