SAPSASA Golf Championships - Conditions

Eligibility:

The championship is open to Primary BOYS and GIRLS in Years 5, 6 and 7 with OR without handicaps who are enrolled and attending a school affiliated with SAPSASA. Students who are turning 10 in the year of competition but are in year 4 and are exceptionally talented golfers may seek permission to play in the championship in order to be considered for the SAPSASA 12 and under state team.

Rules:

Players are expected to have some golf experience and to understand and use the standard rules of golf and the specific tournament local rules, also to have some understanding of golf etiquette.

Qualifying:

All boys and girls must enter the competition through clinics or club golf and play in the District or Metro Qualifying Days. All players must submit an individual entry form before the due date.

80 players will qualify for the Country Championship and 80 players will qualify for the Metro Championship. At least 20% of these must be girls.

Championship Format:

The Championships will be a 2 day event. Both the Metropolitan and Country Championships will be held on the same day (Day 1) with tee times to be posted on SAPSASA & Golf SA websites at least one week prior to the event. Metro players will be allocated the earlier time slots.

A State Championship Day will be held on Day 2. The top 44 golfers from the Metro and Country Championships will play in the State Championships with a maximum of 36 boys and a minimum of 8 girls. All players are required to report at 8.00am and to check the seeded draw for hit off time.

Players who do not qualify for the State Championship are expected to participate in an 18 hole Golf SA Invitational. All players must report at 8.00am.

SAPSASA 12 and under state team

This event is one of the major criteria in the selection process and all players who are eligible to be selected should play in this event. The team is selected by the SAPSASA panel. To be eligible players must be at least 10 years old and no older than 12 years in the year of the event. Exceptional golfers who are aged 10 and in year 4 may seek permission to play in the championship.

Medals & Trophies:

SAPSASA gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in both the Metro & Country Championships. (Day 1).

Golf SA trophies will be awarded to boys and girls placed 1st, 2nd & 3rd in the State Championships (Day 2). Should players have the same score then these players will receive the same medal / trophy and the next placing will not be awarded. (E.g. If 2 players are equal 1st then the next award is 3rd.)

Supervisors:

Golf SA & SAPSASA will provide personnel to conduct the event. At least one organiser is to be on the course and 3 people to check – in & record etc. Officials will be on course, sourced from the Henley High School Golf program and Golf SA. Parents may be asked to assist as walkers/supervisors but are not to act as a caddie or coach.

Inclement Weather:

Golf SA & SAPSASA weather policies are to apply. In inclement weather the program may be modified. *For example:*

Day 1: No Play then Day 1 program will be conducted on Day 2 and the scores will be used to calculate placings for the State Championship.

Day 1: Part play – Both country & metro players to only play 9 holes either the front or back 9 and these scores used to ascertain qualifiers for the State Championship.

Day 2: No play the Day 1 scores will be used to calculate placings for the State Championship.

Days 1 & 2: No play then the event to be rescheduled.
