IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Practise rounds

Practise rounds will be available at the Club at members rates. Players must contact Andrew or Des directly to make a booking.

Format

Play will be foursomes stroke play over one round of 18-holes, with female players playing from the first tee. Play will be from the 1st and 10th tees, 7.00am – 8.30am.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to register. Registration will be inside the room next to the pro shop. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Rules officials

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course during the day. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food and Beverage

Breakfast will be available from 6.30am – bacon and egg roll plus a tea or coffee for \$7.50. Lunch will be a main course item and salad for \$20. On completion of the event finger food, tea and coffee will be provided by Golf NSW for all competitors.

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Match Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

Dress Regulations

All entrants must comply with the host Club and Golf NSW Standard Dress Regulations. Failure to do so will result in the player not being permitted to commence their round.

Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value: Winners Scratch, Runners Up Scratch, Third Place Scratch, Winners Nett, Runners Up Nett, Third Place Nett.

Presentation

Presentation of all prizes will be at the conclusion of play. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Distance Measuring Devices

Distance Measuring devices may be used, with the specimen local rule on page 140 of the Rules of Golf 2008-2011 in place.

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
