Director Nominations for the Board of Golf NSW

The Constitution of Golf NSW specifies that after the inaugural Board elections held in 2010, subsequently there will be rolling elections every year. On this first re-election there will be four positions that become vacant, and in 2012 the other five positions will fall vacant. This ensures continuity of policy, decision making and general smooth operation of the organisation. The term of a Director is two years, with a maximum of three consecutive terms allowed.

Nominations for the Board will be open from 2nd August until 26th August. Assuming an election is required, the successful candidates will be announced at the AGM on 6th October 2011. Further information and nomination forms will be available from the Golf NSW website – www.golfnsw.org.

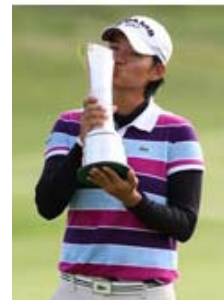
Eight Aussies In Hunt For Women's British Open

Eight Australians will be vying to hold the trophy aloft in the final major of the year at the RICOH Women's British Open which teed off at the famous Carnoustie Golf Links in Scotland yesterday, Thursday 28 July.

Leading the Australian charge, as she has done for over 15 years now, is the Rolex World No.10 and World Golf Hall of Famer **Karrie Webb**. The Queenslander is joined in the field by **Lindsey Wright, Sarah-Jane Smith, Sarah Kemp, Karen Lunn, Kristie Smith, Stacey Keating** and **Frances Bondad**. Bondad was one of 18 players to secure a starting spot through Monday qualifying. ALPG Members **Lynnette Brooky** and **Rebecca Codd** also earned a place in the field through qualifying with Brooky earning equal-medal honours with a round of 3-under par.

144 players teed it up Thursday (Scotland time). The purse for this week is US\$2.5 million, with the winner taking home just over US\$400,000.
