# WOMEN'S MOUNTAIN MEETING CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

## 1. Tournament Procedure

- 1.1 This Event will be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as approved by the R&A Rules Limited, the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for State Events and the Local Rules as approved by the Championship Committee.
- 1.2 **Reductions/Increases in Handicap before close of entries:** It is requested, that if a player reduces or increases her handicap by more than 2 strokes after forwarding her entry and before the closing date, she contact Golf NSW so that she is drawn in the correct Division.  
If a player reduces or increases her handicap after the closing date for entries, she will remain in the Division in which she has been drawn for the duration of the Tournament and compete on her current handicap.
- 1.3 **No reductions or increases in handicap will be made during the Tournament.** Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play. Number of Divisions, Courses to be used, Program and Handicap Limits for each Division will be determined after close of entries. Players will be allocated to a division by Golf NSW based upon their handicap at the time of the draw. In the event of a partner in the Foursomes Event, or a Team Member in the Teams Event, being unable to compete, a substitute will be accepted. No additional fee is payable, provided an Entry Fee for that event has been paid by the original player.
- 1.5 **Ties:** In the event of a tie for the Div. 1, Div. 2 and Div. 3 Perpetual Trophies joint winners will be declared. All other ties to be determined using the Golf Australia Countback method.

## 2. Championship Play Committee

- 2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Women's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.
- 2.3 The Championship Play Committee will have the sole management and control of the Tournament, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- 2.4 Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the event shall be final.
- 2.5 The Championship Play Committee's decision on matters affecting the Tournament will be final.

## 3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 18), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

## 4. Entries

- 4.1 The event is open to female amateur golfers who hold a current Australian, or overseas equivalent handicap. The handicap limit of for this event is 45.
- 4.2 The entry fee is \$35.00 (including GST) per day or \$100.00 (including GST) for four days of play.
- 4.3 Entries must be made via the Golf NSW website, entry form issued by Golf NSW, or a facsimile copy thereof. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form.
- 4.5 Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play. The Championship Committee reserve the right to amend the handicap of a player prior to or during the event.
- 4.6 The decision of the Championship Play Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 4.7 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Ltd, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and shall sign a declaration to that effect contained on the Entry Form or agree to such conditions through the online entry process.  
In the event of an entrant being suspended by an affiliated club, a club affiliated with a District Golf Association, a District Golf Association on a golf related matter the entrant shall not be eligible to enter the event, even if she nominates another club as her home club for handicap purposes.
- 4.8 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by Golf NSW prior to 5.00 pm Monday 19 September 2011. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT TO ENSURE THAT THE ENTRY IS RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES.
- 4.9 In the event of entrants exceeding the number of places available in the event, entries shall be decided by the date received. Such entrants shall be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Entrance fees will be refunded to entrants, who do not subsequently compete. A substitute eligible player will be permitted without the payment of an additional entry fee.
- 4.10 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Play Committee and will incur a \$20 late fee.
- 4.11 Acceptable payment methods are only as follows – credit card (Visa or MasterCard only), cheque (personal or bank), money order, cash (please note that Golf NSW will NOT accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received). Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to Golf NSW.
- 4.12 Only entry forms accompanied by credit card payment will be accepted by facsimile or email. Entry forms accompanied by other acceptable payment methods must be submitted by post or in person. Entries will not be accepted by telephone. Entry forms will not be accepted unless they are fully completed.
- 4.13 Entry fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries, except for those entrants who fail to secure a place, or after the close of entries for medical reasons (a medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds). All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee.
- 4.14 Entrants and their caddy must abide by the dress regulations of the host club

## 5. Exemptions

There are no exemptions for this Tournament.

## 6. Television and Media

All rights for televising live, television recordings or for any visual or electronic reproduction of the Championship are reserved only to Golf NSW and may only be made under licence.

## 7. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting.

## 8. Drug Testing

All competitors are subject to drug testing as outlined in the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

## 9. Code of Conduct

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All entrants are bound by Golf NSW' Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at [www.golfnsw.org](http://www.golfnsw.org). Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or Golf Australia for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or Golf Australia codes of conduct and/or other related matters.

## 10. Motorised Transport

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Is permitted in this tournament, Golf NSW accepts no responsibility for the availability of carts. Players must make their own arrangements to reserve a cart at the course.

## 11. Practice

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Practice rounds prior to the event are at the discretion of the host club. Permission must be sought from the host and practice times may be booked directly with the Professional Shop.

## 12. Registration

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Competitors are to register 30 mins. before their starting time. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the Tournament.

## 13. Pace of Play

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Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

## 17. Database of Competitors' Details

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The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf NSW.
