# NSW COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

---

**These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.**

## **1. Championship Procedure**

---

- 1.1 **The Championship** will be stroke play over 36- holes at Queanbeyan Golf Club over two days. Day 1 – 18 holes, Day 2 – 18 holes. Players are required to play both days.
- 1.2 The winner will be the NSW Country Champion and will receive the Championship Medal, entry into the 2011 Men's NSW Open, and have their names engraved on the Championship Trophy.
- 1.3 The 2011 NSW Junior Country Championship will be played in conjunction with the 2011 Men's NSW Country Championship. All participants under 18 years of age at the time of entry will be eligible for this Championship.
- 1.4 The 2011 Men's NSW Country Inter-District Championship Teams Event will be played concurrently with the 2011 Men's NSW Country Championship. Teams consisting of five male amateur players may be nominated for the Seniors Team, and three junior male amateurs for the Juniors Team. All players participating in the Teams Championship must be eligible to participate in and entered into the 2011 Men's NSW Country Championship. For each round of the Championship, the scratch scores from each team member shall count as the team score. The team with the lowest score from both rounds of the Championship will be the Teams Champions.
- 1.5 TIES: Joint winners will be declared in the Country and Junior Championship events, if scores are tied. All other ties will be determined using the Golf Australia countback system.
- 1.6 Scratch and nett trophies will be awarded, with a limit of one trophy per person (awarded in order of value).

## **2. Championship Play Committee**

---

- 2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Men's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.
- 2.3 The Championship Play Committee will have the sole management and control of the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- 2.4 The Championship Play Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final.

## **3. Rules of Play**

---

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

## **4. Entries**

---

- 4.1 The Championship is open to male amateurs who:
  - (a) hold a current Australian, or overseas equivalent handicap that does not exceed the handicap limit of 9.4 at the time of entry; and
  - (b) are Members of a Country Golf Club affiliated with Golf NSW; and
  - (c) are a bona fide ACT or NSW resident outside the Sydney Metropolitan Area (defined as the County of Cumberland) (see exception).Exception: An entrant who resides within 50kms of a NSW state border who meets the other membership criteria in the Condition C1 may be eligible subject to the approval of the Championship Committee provided he is also a member of a District Team competing in the Inter-District Teams competition.
- 4.2 The entry fee is \$60 online or \$70 for all other forms of entry.
- 4.3 Entries must be made via the Golf NSW website, entry form issued by Golf NSW, or a facsimile copy thereof. Entry by email is acceptable provided it is a scanned image of the official entry form.
- 4.4 Any player who has entered the Championship on a correct handicap whose handicap has increased beyond the handicap limit for the Championship will be permitted to play in the Championship on their current handicap.
- 4.5 Players will compete for the duration of the Championship on the handicap current on the first day of play (exception: see Condition 4.4). The Championship Committee reserve the right to amend the handicap of a player prior to or during the event.
- 4.6 The decision of the Championship Play Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 4.7 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited.
- 4.8 Fully completed Entry Forms must be received by Golf NSW prior to 5.00 pm Friday 9 September 2011. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT TO ENSURE THAT THE ENTRY IS RECEIVED PRIOR TO THE CLOSING TIME FOR ENTRIES. A player's entry form has not officially been received until their name has been posted at [www.golfnsw.org](http://www.golfnsw.org).
- 4.9 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championships (168 players), applications from those higher handicap competitors not exempt from a handicap ballot as detailed in Condition 5 will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.10 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Play Committee and will incur a \$20 late fee.
- 4.11 Acceptable payment methods are only as follows – credit card (Visa or MasterCard only), cheque (personal or bank), money order, cash (please note that Golf NSW will NOT accept responsibility for cash sent that is not received). Cheques or money orders are to be made payable to Golf NSW.
- 4.12 Only entry forms accompanied by credit card payment will be accepted by facsimile or email. Entry forms accompanied by other acceptable payment methods must be submitted by post or in person. Entries will not be accepted by telephone. Entry forms will not be accepted unless they are fully completed.
- 4.13 Entry fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries, except for those entrants who fail to secure a place, or after the close of entries for medical reasons (a medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds). All refunds will incur a \$10 processing fee.
- 4.14 Entrants and their caddy must abide by the dress regulations of the host club.

---

**5. Exemptions**

5.1 There are no exemptions for this Championship.

---

**6. Television and Media**

All rights for televising live, television recordings or for any visual or electronic reproduction of the Championship are reserved only to Golf NSW and may only be made under licence.

---

**7. Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting**

The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls, Conforming Driver Heads, and Time of Starting.

---

**8. Drug Testing**

All competitors are subject to drug testing as outlined in the Golf NSW Code of Conduct.

---

**9. Code of Conduct**

All entrants are bound by Golf NSW' Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at [www.golfnsw.org](http://www.golfnsw.org). Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or Golf Australia for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or Golf Australia codes of conduct and/or other related matters.

---

**10. Motorised Transport**

The Golf NSW Standard Condition is in effect. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Match Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry.

Note i: Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

**11. Practice**

**12. Registration**

Competitors are to register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play. Failure to comply may result in disqualification from the Championship.

---

**13. Pace of Play**

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

---

**14. Prizes**

Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

- (i) NSW Country Championship (scratch) – 1<sup>st</sup> place
- (ii) NSW Country Championship (scratch) – 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- (iii) NSW Country Championship (scratch) – 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- (iv) NSW Country Junior Championship (scratch) – 1<sup>st</sup> place
- (v) NSW Country Junior Championship (scratch) – 2<sup>nd</sup> place
- (vi) NSW Country Junior Championship (scratch) – 3<sup>rd</sup> place
- (vii) 36 Holes Nett Winner
- (viii) 36 Holes Nett Runner Up
- (ix) 1<sup>st</sup> 18 Holes – Scratch Winner
- (x) 2<sup>nd</sup> 18 Holes – Scratch Winner

Please note: Juniors are those under 18 years of age as at the first day of play. Competitors may win only one prize, with the exception that a Junior may win both the Country and Junior Championship.

---

**15. Database of Competitors' Details**

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf NSW. This data may be utilised by Golf NSW or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf NSW e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf NSW events, or information about events conducted by Golf NSW-approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf NSW of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

**16. Golf NSW Hard Card**

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout the NSW Country Championship.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
