CONDITIONS OF PLAY:

1. The Match Committee of Cammeray Golf Club has the final say in all matters concerning this event and no correspondence will be entered into.
2. The Cammeray Cup is open to male members of Affiliated Clubs with handicaps of 10 and under and the male members of Cammeray Golf Club with a handicap of 36 or less.
3. The Club reserves the right to limit the number of entries by ballot, if necessary.
4. The Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf and any Local Rules of the day. Please be sure to read the Local Rules Board.
5. **Players must register with the starter at least 15 minutes prior to their hit off time.**
6. **PACE OF PLAY-** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must play without undue delay and must maintain its position the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties may be issued to individuals who are guilty of slow play. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties being imposed.
7. **Locomotion:** Players will not generally be permitted to ride in, or on, any form of automotive locomotion during the play of the stipulated round. An exception will be made in the case of a player affected by disability, which makes it necessary to use automotive locomotion. It will be necessary for the player seeking exception to produce the following: (a) a certificate or letter from a Medical Practitioner specifying i) the disability by which the player is affected; ii) the medical practitioner's opinion that the disability necessitates the players requiring the use of automotive locomotion to participate in the competition; (b) in the case of permanent disability a letter from the secretary of the Club, confirming that the player does not presently participate in any games of golf at the Club except with the assistance of automotive locomotion; or (c) in the case of a temporary disability a letter from the secretary of the Club confirming the player does not presently participate in any games of golf except with the assistance of automotive locomotion and nominating the period for which such permission is granted.
8. Mobile Phones – the use of a mobile phone by a competitor or his caddy whilst on the golf course, during an event is prohibited. Penalty – disqualification.
9. You must carry and use a sand bucket.
10. No stopping at halfway – players are to proceed directly to the next tee at all times during the round.
11. In the event of a tie for the Cammeray Cup, a sudden death play-off will be held. All other events will be decided by countback.
12. The entry fee of \$25 per player must accompany the entry form and must include the player's Golflink number or a handicap record signed by the Manager of the Club.
13. A player may not win more than one Trophy Prize (highest value Trophy Prize will be awarded).
