2012 Avondale Bowl Conditions of Play

ELIGIBILITY: The Avondale Bowl is open to those with an Australian Women's Handicap, not exceeding 22.4 at time of entry.

Any player who enters on a handicap within the prescribed limit at close of entry, and whose handicap increases beyond the limit, will be permitted to compete on the maximum handicap.

If a player's handicap alters after the first round of the competition, her original handicap shall apply to the 36 hole handicap event but the second 18 hole handicap event shall be played on her altered handicap.

ENTRY: Entries must be made on the official entry form and entry fees must accompany the entry form.

Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Captain and will play where the draw allows.

Cancellations after Tuesday 12 noon prior to the event are non-refundable except upon the production of a medical certificate or after a written request at the discretion of the Committee.

Substitute players will not be accepted

THE DRAW: The first round will be played as a seeded draw using playing handicaps (whole number) in ascending order.

The second round will be played as a seeded draw in descending order of playing handicap.

The draw will be available on the front page of the Avondale website (avondalegolfclub.com.au)

TROPHIES: Winner of the Bowl – best scratch 36 holes

Runner-up of the Bowl – scratch 36 holes

Nett winner – 36 holes

Nett runner-up – 36 holes

1st and 2nd Day – 2 Divisions: Day 1 18 hole scratch winner in both divisions

18 hole nett winner in both divisions

Day 2 18 hole scratch winner in both divisions

18 hole nett winner in both divisions

TIES: In the event of the combined gross scores for the two days being tied, a "sudden death" play-off will determine the winner, or at the discretion of the Ladies Committee, joint winners will be declared.

The winner of the nett event is decided by count-back.

CADDIES & CARTS: Players may have a caddie.

Motorised transport is permitted providing the player has a current medical certificate issued within the preceding 12 months. A copy must be attached to the entry form.

MOBILE PHONES: As per NSWG standard conditions of play

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICE: For all play at this course, a player may obtain distance information by using a device that measures distance only. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play (eg gradient, windspeed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional function is used.

The Committee shall have full power to alter or make any variations to the Conditions should it deem it desirable.
