What does this mean ?

It means that whenever a golfer achieves a 'hole in one', they enter the "De Bortoli Wines Hole in One Club" – a club that recognizes and rewards that rare feat, which is arguably the greatest achievement a golfer can execute on a golf course.

Through the support of De Bortoli Wines, successful golfers receive the following:-

- a personalised certificate
- a letter of congratulations
- a unique presence on the hole in one website
- publication in Pacific Golfer magazine, and
- a gift pack containing 2 bottles of De Bortoli Wine

Entry is naturally by securing a hole in one but this must be in a recognized official club competition, and must be over 18 years of age with an official Golf Australia handicap.

De Bortoli Wines is a family owned company that has wineries in a diverse number of wine growing regions across Australia – the Bilbul winery in the Riverina region of NSW, the famous Hunter Valley, the Yarra Valley, and the popular King Valley region of north eastern Victoria.

To be eligible, the golf club needs to stock any of De Bortoli's wines to be able to provide the wine as one of the rewards.

Clubs can select from a range of De Bortoli's product and can arrange this through a local De Bortoli Wines representative, or contact Golf NSW for arrangements to be made for a representative to visit to discuss ways in which a supply arrangement can be organised.

The club completes a 'Nomination Form' which forms part of the Information Pack provided to each club that participates in the arrangement.

Through De Bortoli's support of this initiative, Golf NSW is able to continue to develop golf throughout NSW and to provide a reward to amateur golfers who are fortunate to have struck the perfect (or in some instances, not so perfect) shot which becomes a 'hole in one'.
