This event is an opportunity for family members to enjoy a day of golf together, and compete against other families.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE EVENT

Each two-person team must have an immediate family relationship (step-parents, adopted parents and de-facto inclusive) which must be stated on the entry form.

Some examples of eligible combinations are found below:

Father/Son; Father/Daughter; Mother/Son; Mother/Daughter; Husband/Wife; Brothers; Sisters; Brother/Sister; Uncle/Nephew; Uncle/Niece; Aunt/Nephew; Aunt/Niece; Grandparent/Grand-son or daughter; First Cousins; Father/Daughter or Son in law; Mother/ Daughter or Son in law.

“Family” means:

- a pair who are related by blood, by marriage or kinship;
- a pair who are in a bona fide domestic or household relationship
- a relationship between the pair through adoption (i.e. an adopted child or the adopted child of the person who is in a bona fide domestic or household relationship with the player)

The respective sections are open to two person teams as specified below:

Men’s Section - two male players;

Women’s Section - two female players

Mixed Section - one male and one female player.

Prizes will be awarded in each of the above sections (prizes in each section may be reduced if small numbers of entrants), plus an overall winning pair.

Eligibility

- Open to all amateur golfers with a Golf Australia handicap.
- No age restriction – this allows all family members to compete together

ENTRY FEE: \$100 per pair online, or \$110 per pair for other methods of entry

2012 NSW FAMILY BOWL CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Event Procedure

1.1 **The Event** will be played as follows:

The NSW Family Bowl – fourball stableford play over one round of 18 holes, at Cabramatta Golf Club. All ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Event Play Committee

2.1 The Event Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Men's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.

2.2 In the absence of a full Event Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Event Play Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Event Play Committee.

4. Entries

4.1 **Handicap:** Eligible players are male or female amateurs whose Australian Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 35.4 (men) or 44.4 (women) at the time of entry.

4.2 **Age:** There is no age restriction in this event.

4.3 **Entry Fee:** the entry fee applicable for this event is \$100 per pair online or \$110 per pair for all other forms of entry.

4.4 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the event, a ballot will be performed based upon date of receipt of entry. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.

4.5 **Exemptions:** There are no exemptions for this event.

5. Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Event are at the discretion of the host club. Permission must be sought from the host club's Office for play.

Practice rounds are available Monday – Friday anytime except if there is a Corporate Day. Cost is \$27.00 per player. Weekend practice rounds available after 3:30pm or players may play in competition.

7. Registration

Competitors are encouraged to register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

Overall winners (nett)

Overall winners (scratch)

Men's Winners and Runners Up (nett)

Women's Winners and Runners Up (nett)

Mixed Winners and Runners Up (nett)

10. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
