2012 NSW SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Championship Procedure

1.1 **The Championship** will be played as follows:

The NSW Senior Championship – stroke play over three rounds of 18 holes, all at Lynwood Country Club. At the conclusion of the second round of stroke play, a seeded draw will take place for round three. The entire field are expected to contest all three rounds and must play as drawn. There will be no opportunity for players to change or request tee times for round 3. The leading player(s) at the end of this stroke play shall be the **2012 NSW Senior Champion**. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by sudden death play-off. If insufficient time is available for a play-off, joint winners will be declared. All other ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Championship Play Committee

2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Men's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager - Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.

2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

4. Entries

4.1 **Handicap:** Eligible players are male amateurs whose Australian Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 15.4 strokes at the time of entry.

4.2 **Age:** Eligible players must be 55 years of age or over as at the first day of play.

4.3 **Entry Fee:** the entry fee applicable for this event is \$95 online or \$105 for all other forms of entry.

4.4 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, applications from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.

4.5 **Exemptions:** There are no exemptions for this Championship.

5. Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Championship are at the discretion of the host club.

Lynwood Country Club - Practice rounds will be available for tournament entrants for a green fee of \$20.00 per round for the week preceding the tournament.

Entrants are welcome to play in competitions on the preceding Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Saturday and Sunday.

On Monday, 27th February, the course has been reserved exclusively for the Senior Championship entrants.

Practice / warm up balls will be available at the range at Lynwood Country Club at no charge to players for the event.

7. Registration

Competitors **MUST** register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize (exception: NSW Senior Country Champion). Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:

NSW Senior Championship, J.R. Higson Trophy (54 holes Stroke Play) - Winner; Runner Up; 3rd Place

Division 1 (55-59 years) – Scratch and Nett Winner

Division 2 (6-64 years) – Scratch and Nett Winner

Division 3 (65-69 years) – Scratch and Nett Winner

Division 4 (70 years and over) – Scratch and Nett Winner

NSW Senior Country Champion (for those that reside in NSW or the ACT and are a member of a non-metropolitan golf club and reside outside the County of Cumberland) - Winner

10. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
