ADAM CRAWFORD (QLD) played near flawless golf to win the NSW Open trophy by one shot. After sharing the lead for most of the tournament Paul Donahoo closed out the round with a disappointing bogey on 18. Donahoo finished tied for 2nd at 5 under par with Anthony Summers, and Jake Higginbottom. However, it was 13 year-old Charlstown golfer, Blake Windred that stole the limelight during the week when he became the youngest ever golfer to qualify for the NSW Open and perhaps even any professional golf tournament.

Gerrigong win 2011 NSW Women's 3BBB State Final

DESPITE a wild storm and an Elton John concert the night prior, the 2011 NSW Women's 3BBB State Final was played in good conditions at Cypress Lakes Golf Resort. 21 teams, 8 from Metropolitan Sydney & 13 from Country NSW battled it out over 18 holes with Gerrigong Golf Club who took the top gong. The winning team comprised Pamela Ford (22), Lola Scott (33) and Kate Quinn (40).





Kato awarded highest honour

RICKY KATO has been awarded the highest individual honour by the Combined High School Sports Association at a recent presentation night. Ricky was awarded the Vale Lembit Trophy as the most outstanding male athlete in the Combined High School Sports Association etching his name in history along with lan Thorpe & Nick Flanagan.

THE National Women's Holden Scramble Champions secured a trip to China to compete in a 2012 International Friendly V China event. The Cromer team of Katrina Brown, Nick Robb (Club Professional), Beverley Fagan, Yvonne Burns and Adele Brimmer outperformed 35,000 golfers on a journey that saw them compete in events from 23rd August at Cromer to 21st October on the Sunshine Coast.

Shelly, who is on a handicap of +1, has had a stellar year and recently crowned with numerous titles under her belt. She was also crowned the Combined High Schools and the Golf NSW Schoolgirl Champion. State Liberal MP Greg Smith presented her, along with 6 others, a NSW State Representative Certificate.

THE Golf NSW Men's Senior Order of Merit has concluded for 2011 after 35 events were keenly contested all around NSW and ACT. In the end it was familiar face of Denis Dale (Twin Creeks GC) with 2010 points who took out first place in the Open division. He was followed by Men's Australian Seniors champion, Stefan Albinski (Mona Vale GC) on 1790 points and Stephen Gibson (St Michael's GC) on 1670 points.



Women's International Bowl

THE International Bowl's Overall Winner was Division 3 winner Mary O'Connell (Bondi Diggers). Judy Smith (The Coast) won Division 1 and Maureen Keogh (Murrumbidgee) won Division 2. There were 3168 women who participated in the international bowl. The event is played between 1 January - 30 September and open to female amateurs in 18-hole stroke handicap events. The Overall Winner wins a trip to the Women's Australian Open & a place in the Pro-Am.





Goodwill Plate raises \$9000 to charity

THE Goodwill Plate is a special annual competition to raise funds for Charity recommended by Golf NSW. This year \$9000 was raised for Carers NSW and the Melanoma & Skin Cancer Research Institute. The State Winner was Annie Walker (Richmond) with a score of -12. Annie competed along with 4614 women across NSW and ACT between 1 Jan - 30 Sept. The State Winner is determined by the number of strokes (if any), the nett result is under the AWCR of the course on the day of play.



Somers successfully defends Australian Hickory Title

The ladies competition was another double win by Jane Buckley who beat Liz Buckley (no relation) by 2 shots.




OFFICE of Communities Sport & Recreation

A list of 2011 Amateur Honour roles for national and state titles was also covered in the magazine.

In the November 2011 Golfer Pacific magazine, they named the "Cream of the Crop for the Top 50 Most Influential Figures in the history of the PGA of Australia." **Greg Norman** topped the list at No. 1 as a player, entrepreneur and golf course designer...

The Australian Golf Media Awards was held on 19 November at the Lakes Golf Club honouring 11 recipients on the best golf media coverage for articles, photography, television and radio commentating. The coveted Tom Ramsey Award for Excellence in Journalism was presented to **Brett Robinson**, for his article on Cottesloe Golf course superintendent John Bourne in the Australian Turfgrass Management journal (Volume 13.1 - Jan/Feb 2011 issue). The **West course** at **Royal Melbourne Golf Club** has been recognised as the best course in Australia, although some claim that its neighbour **Kingston Heath** would be regarded as the premier course in Australia. The **New South Wales Golf Club** comes third and rated as "one of the toughest tests in the country" according to the *top 100 golfcourses of the World we site*.

In five out of the six categories, NSW players are listed at the top of the *Australian Amateur Rankings*. From NSW **Cathleen Santoso** (Girls), **Ricky Kato** (Boys), and **Matt Stieger** (Men's), **Sylvia Donohoe** (Senior Women) and **Stefan Albinski** (Senior Men) made the top listing in their respective age groups for 2011. Only one category, Women's, went to another state, WA's Jessica Speechley.
