2012 GOLD COAST SENIOR AMATEUR TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf QLD Standard Conditions for Events run by Golf QLD, the Golf QLD Code of Conduct and the Golf QLD Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Tournament Procedure

- 1.1 The tournament will be played as follows:
The Gold Coast Senior Amateur – stroke play over two rounds of 18 holes, the first round at Coolangatta Tweed Golf Club and the second round at Lakelands Golf Club. Both events will be Shotgun starts at 11.30am
The entire field are expected to contest both events and must play as drawn.
There will be no opportunity for players to change or request tee times.
The leading player(s) at the end of this stroke play shall be the 2012 Gold Coast Senior Amateur Champion.
In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by sudden death play-off'.
If insufficient time is available for a play-off, joint winners will be declared.
All other ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

2. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, together with Golf QLD Hard Card, and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Tournament Play Committee, will apply for the duration of the tournament.

3. Tournament Play Committee

- 3.1 The Tournament Play Committee, together with QLD. Rules officials and/or their appointees, will be responsible for the application of the Rules of Golf for the duration of the tournament.
- 3.2 In the absence of a full Tournament Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Tournament Play Committee.

4. Entries

- 4.1 Handicap: Eligible players are male amateurs whose Australian Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 18.4 strokes at the time of entry.
- 4.2 Handicaps will be frozen for the duration of the tournament, but correct handicap must be notified by the player at registration before the first days play.
- 4.2 Age: Eligible players must be 55 years of age or over as at the first day of play.
- 4.3 Entry Fee: the entry fee applicable for this event is \$105 online or \$115 for all other forms of entry.
- 4.4 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Tournament, applications from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 Exemptions: There are no exemptions for this Championship.

5. Motorised Transport

Motorised transport is compulsory for play on both courses during the tournament, the cost being included in the entry fee.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Tournament are at the discretion of the host club.
Bookings can be made through the Pro Shop for both courses. **Coolangatta – (07) 5524 4644. Lakelands – (07) 5510 6507.**
The cost of practise / warm up balls will be borne by the individual player.

7. Registration

Competitors MUST register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf QLD Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Competitors may win one prize only, gross or nett. Prizes will be awarded in the following order based on value:
Gold Coast Senior Amateur Champion. (36 holes Stroke Play) - Winner; Runner Up; 3rd Place.
Division 1 (55-59 years) – Scratch Winner and Runner Up.
Division 2 (60-64 years) – Scratch Winner and Runner Up.
Division 3 (65-69 years) – Scratch Winner and Runner Up.
Division 4 (70 years and over) – Scratch Winner and Runner Up.
Daily Nett Prizes will be awarded in each age Division – Nett Winner, Runner Up.
Total prize pool in excess of \$2500.00.

10. Golf QLD Hard Card

The Golf QLD Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.
Note i: Conforming Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.
Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
