CONDITIONS

■ The RDGC Open will be a single stroke event played over 36 holes on Saturday 16th & Sunday 17th June 2012. There will be daily grade nett prizes, as well as Overall Gross and Nett. Nominations fee of \$40.00 (GST inc.) must be paid prior to play on the first day. **Entries close at 1200 on 13th June 2012, or when the field is full (whichever first occurs).**

• Competitors must be a financial member with their Home Club and have a current Golf Australia handicap to compete. The following handicaps will apply:

MENS: 36 MAXIMUM Grades: A 0-12, B 13-18 and C 19-36

LADIES: 45 MAXIMUM Grades: A 0-20 and B 21-45 (subject to numbers)

ALL COMPETITORS MUST PROVIDE PROOF OF EXACT HANDICAP BY USE OF GOLFLINK NUMBER OR FROM THEIR HOME CLUB TO MATCH COMMITTEE OR STARTER PRIOR TO TEE-OFF.

- The Ladies and Men's Open champion will be the respective with the LOWEST GROSS score accumulated during play on Saturday and Sunday 36 hole event.
- Competitors may not be awarded more than ONE MINOR prize on any day and no more than ONE MAJOR event prize at the completion of the Open. The Trophies will be presented as per the entry form on Sunday after the competition.
- All men's events will be played from the WHITE TEE MARKERS and all ladies events will be played from the RED TEE MARKERS. (**NB most markers are painted red and white**)
- STARTING TIMES. A draw for each day's play will be made (a starting sheet will be available at the club for those wishing to pick their own time, up until 1700 on 13 June 2012) and published. Players shall start at the time allocated and in order arranged by the committee. All players are required to report to the starter at least 10 minutes before their appointed time. Rule 6-3a shall apply to players arriving after their stipulated time.
- In the event of a tie for Open Champions there will be a sudden death playoff. Commencing on hole 1 then hole 18 continually until a result is reached. Winners for all other ties will be decided by normal Golf Australia countback system.
- The match committee will be seeding the top four or eight scores (subject to numbers) in each of the Men's Grades and each of the Ladies Grades (if more than one) on Sunday 17th June 2012. (No exceptions, so persons who are seeded but unable to play at the appointed time will still be eligible for daily prizes BUT NOT overall prizes)
- The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, Scotland and The American Golf Association, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be taken to the Match Committee whose decision will be final.
