Conditions of Entry

1. Entries will be limited to 200 players.
2. Tee times will be allocated according to handicap (special requests will be considered but cannot be guaranteed).
3. Entry fee must be paid with the registration form (each entrant must fill in a separate form). Refunds will be made for cancellations made before 10th October 2012. Refunds for cancellations after this date will be at the discretion of the McCracken Golf Club Committee.
4. Play will be governed by the Rules of Golf (as approved by R&A Rules Limited), the Australian Golf Union, Women's Golf Australia and Local Rules as posted. Disputes will be decided by McCracken Match Committee and its decisions shall be binding and final.
5. Only players with official AGU or WGA sanctioned handicaps may enter. Handicap limits are men 36 and women 45. Players registered on Golf Link must provide their full Golf Link number on registration. Players not on Golf Link must provide notification of their exact handicap.
6. The McCracken Cup will consist of two Stableford rounds with daily prizes, as well as overall tournament prizes to be awarded on an aggregate basis.
7. Handicaps will be adjusted following the first round. This updated/current handicap must be used for the second round.
8. Daily A, B & C grades will be conducted for men and A & B grades for women. Grade handicap limits will be adjusted before the event to ensure that there are approximately equal numbers of players in each grade. Players will remain in the initial grade for the duration of event.
9. Tied results will be decided using AGU count back procedures.
10. Players are requested to report to the starter 30 minutes before the tee off time.
11. Use of motorised carts and devices used for measuring distance only is allowed for this event.
12. Presentations will be Sunday 14th after the final round.
