PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It is my pleasure, on behalf of the Board, to present the 2011 Annual Report of Golf Tasmania. The Board met bi-monthly during the year to deal with the business of the Association and I sincerely thank our Board Members, Helen Langenberg, Paul Beard, Andrew Hill, Craig Clark and Bob Joel (who replaced Craig Seymour mid -year) for their dedication and commitment to their board tasks and also to the additional duties performed with various committees and specialist areas.



INDEPENDENT REVIEW

Early in the year the Board approved an Independent Review of the structure and operations of Golf Tasmania with a view to improving service delivery and minimising the overall cost of running the organisation. The review was completed in October 2011 and contained a total of twenty eight recommendations which were subsequently approved by the Board and are being progressively implemented.

STAFFING

In September 2011 two members of our Staff resigned. Following the resignation of the Executive Director, Richard Skeggs, an interim arrangement was implemented by the Board. Mrs Patty Johnson B. Com, CPA was appointed to the position of Business Manager on a part-time basis and Stuart Eaton was appointed as the Operations Manager. The Board also approved an interim arrangement for the delivery of the MYGolf Junior Program to schools following the resignation of the Junior Development Officer Terri Dunn.

The Board anticipates that the interim arrangements will be for a period of approximately six months which will allow the organisation to consolidate its financial position and implement the majority of the Review recommendations.

On behalf of the Board I extend sincere appreciation to Stuart Eaton, Patty Johnson and Joan Cash for the dedicated and professional performance of their duties during a difficult period of time. I would also like to express the Boards appreciation to our contracted regional MYGolf Development Officers Daniel Blackwell and Peter Webster for their delivery of the program to the schools.

PROPERTY

During the year the renovation and refurbishment of Golf House in Bellerive was completed. The building has been modernised and now provides good quality office accommodation, a new meeting room and safer working environment for our staff as well as providing a more professional corporate image of Golf Tasmania.

A new market valuation was obtained for the building and details can be found in the Financial Statements.

STATE TEAMS

On the playing side, the performance of our state representatives in national individual and teams events has once again been commendable and I extend my congratulations to all players. The Board also extends its appreciation to coaches Nick White, Brent Barlow and Daniel Blackwell and Managers Don Cameron, Gary Purdon, Derryn Johnstone and Rod Eiszele for their most valuable service. Congratulations are also extended to senior State representatives Ryan McCarthy, and Ashlee Dewhurst who were rewarded for their outstanding performances during the year with national selection.

COMMITTEES AND VOLUNTEERS

This organisation could not operate without the various committees and volunteers who assist with the running of our major events. I express the Boards appreciation to the members of the Championship, Handicapping, Junior Golf, State Selection and Course Rating Committees and to the many club volunteers. You have all performed most enthusiastically and professionally and we are indebted to you for the voluntary work you so willingly undertake for the benefit of our sport.

SPONSORS

The Board acknowledges and thanks our national sponsor Srixon and our local sponsors particularly Country Club Tasmania, The Tote, Sport and Recreation Tasmania, James Boag, L'Oreal, Schweppes and Events Tasmania for their on-going support. We look forward to maintaining our close working and mutually beneficial relationship.

CONCLUSION

Although 2011 again saw a reduction in the number of club members it is heartening to see that we still have 68 clubs as members of Golf Tasmania. While some clubs are struggling for members others are actually increasing and with the success of highly rated resort courses such as Barnbogle and Lost Farm and recent speculation about new golf course developments there appears to be cause for optimism about the future of golf in Tasmania. It is vital therefore that Golf Tasmania works closely with the member clubs and all stakeholders to maximise public interest in the game and convince players of the benefits of club membership.

On behalf of the Board I thank all member clubs and District Associations for your assistance in 2011 and seek your continuing support for the future management of the sport in this State.

OPERATIONS REPORT

2011 has been another busy and successful year for Golf Tasmania, but also a year that held many challenges.

EVENTS

Golf Tasmania had another successful year conducting the State's major events for both the elite and grass roots golfers. Please see the details contained within the later stages of this annual report for further information.

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT

Spring Camp

Golf Tasmania reintroduced the Spring Junior Golf Camp in 2011 which was conducted from September 11-15 at Camp Clayton, Ulverstone.

The camp took in some of the finest courses on the North West Coast including Devonport, Ulverstone and Port Sorell.

MYGolf

Prior to Golf Tasmania Development Officer Terry Dunn's departure MYGolf clinics had been conducted at twenty one educational institutions. A total of 2,715 children were exposed to golf through this National program.

MYGolf has continued with the part-time employment of Golf Professional, Daniel Blackwell, coordinating the program in the South and Target Golf's, Peter Webster, operating in the North and North West of the State. This commitment to MYGolf for Schools continued until the end of 2011, visiting in excess of 45 primary and secondary educational institutions.

Come and Try Days

Come and Try Days were conducted at various host clubs during 2011. This initiative is a successful way of introducing juniors and adults to the game of golf. Golf Tasmania is committed to conducting these days in years to come.

USGA COURSE RATING

Thank you to Don Cameron and Kaye Hartam who completed rating Golf Tasmania's member courses under the new USGA Course Rating System in 2011. These ratings have all been processed on the USGA's online rating program and the resulting scratch ratings were circulated amongst the member clubs.

Golf Tasmania's Rating Committee will be revisiting member clubs over the coming months/year to assess adjustments (additional courses and amendments to established courses).

RULES ACCREDITATION

Golf Tasmania continues to deliver the Golf Australia Club Level Rules Accreditation Course across the State. Rules workshops were delivered in Southern and Northern Tasmania during the later part of 2011. This course caters for those individuals looking to develop their knowledge and/or delivery of the Rules of Golf.

Thank you to Bruce Eaton who conducted these workshops on behalf of Golf Tasmania during 2011.

COMMUNITY GOLF COACH ONE ACCREDITATION

With the assistance of Golf Australia and the PGA, Golf Tasmania successfully conducted the reinvigorated Community Golf Coach One Accreditation program and saw a significant number of people successfully achieve accreditation.

WOMEN'S PARTICIPATION

In accordance with the Operational Plan, Golf Tasmania focused on continuing to facilitate women's participation during 2011, in particular through the Business Women's Championship.

The championship was conducted by Golf Tasmania for the first time at the Llanherne Golf Club with great success.

TREASURER'S REPORT

The enclosed Financial Report provides full financial disclosure of the year ended 31st December, 2011.



The 2011 year saw Golf Tasmania produce an accrual profit of \$150,644. This large profit was mainly as a result of Golf Tasmania, having reviewed its previous liabilities and seeking agreement with Golf Australia confirming that Golf Tasmania does not owe any monies to Golf Australia for affiliation fees as at 31 December 2011. The adjustment amount to liabilities and capitation fees is \$113,350.

However, a real profit was made as a result of the interim organisational restructure and other cost saving measures introduced by the Board towards the latter part of the reporting year.

On a comparative basis the 2011 result is an increase in operating profit against the 2010 financial year:

Revenue increased by \$103,841 and expenditure decreased by \$28,209. The main movement in income is as detailed above and the decrease in expenditure is mainly due to the interim organisational restructure and the reduction of costs on an efficiency and effectiveness basis. The reduction in costs on an efficiency and effectiveness basis will continue into 2012.

Looking forward to 2012, there will more emphasis on increasing sponsorship revenue, reducing costs and focusing on delivering greater value, with savings being directly injected into improving memberships at member golf clubs.

TASMANIAN OPEN

The 2011 TOTE Tasmanian Open was hosted by the Kingston Beach Golf Club which also hosted the event in 2010.

It is still very pleasing to hear that interstate players rank it as one of the best run tournaments for amateur golfers in the country.

This year's entries totalled 87 competitors. The event attracted 8 internationals, 41 mainlanders and 38 local competitors.

New South Welshman Matt Stieger won the championship by seven strokes from Brett Drewitt also from New South Wales.

Stieger finished the event with scores of 65, 67, 69 and 70, a 72-hole thirteen-under-par total of 271.

Daniel Bringolf from New South Wales and David Coupland from England tied for third on 280 (-4).

New South Wales won the Invitational Teams event played in conjunction with the open with a score of 560. Matt Stieger and Brett Drewitt represented New South Wales.

ELVIE WHITESIDES 72-HOLE STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

The 2011 Elvie Whitesides 72-Hole Stroke Play Championship was hosted by the Launceston Golf Club from Sunday 20 - Tuesday 22 November.

Thirty three competitors, including 21 mainlanders and internationals entered the women's national ranking event.

The event was won by Minjee Lee of Western Australia with scores of 72, 68, 78 and 74, a total of 292.

Lee finished four over the card and one shot clear of Tasmania's Ashlee Dewhurst on 293.

Third place went to Singapore's Charlotte Thomas on 299 with Japan's Saki Suzuki in fourth place on 300.

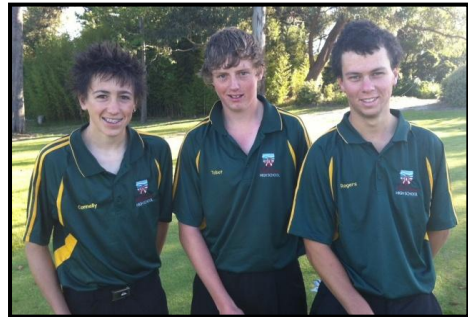

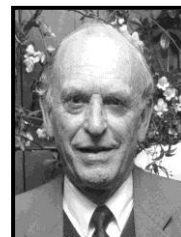
