# **NCAS COMMUNITY GOLF COACH 1**

## **INFORMATION**

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING**

As this course is golf specific, you will need to golf clubs and appropriate golf attire. You will need to protect against the elements (hat, sunscreen, drink bottle etc).

The time set for this course is 8.00am-5.00pm, although exact timings may vary depending on the number of participants.

All participants will also be required to bring writing materials.

Morning tea and lunch will be supplied to all participants.

### **MANUALS AND COURSE MATERIALS**

All golf specific manuals are supplied, along with course paperwork, which must be completed and returned to Golf Tasmania within four (4) weeks of the course completion

### **COACHING GENERAL PRINCIPLES COURSE**

It is preferable that all participants complete the Coaching General Principles course (or teaching equivalent) provided by the Australian Sports Commission before attending the NCAS Community Golf Coach 1 course.

The Coaching General Principles course is a self-paced assessment which can be completed online by visiting the Australian Sports Commission website.

Prior to being registered as a Community Golf Coach, all participants will be assessed on current ability to complete various coaching tasks and demonstrations. All details will be supplied during the course.

### **BREACH OF AMATEUR STATUS**

Should any accredited coach, other than a member of the Professional Golf Association, be found to have breached the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by the R&A Rules Ltd that results in the loss of their amateur status, coaching accreditation will be revoked.
