Tournament Function:

Australian Men's Senior Match Play Championship: Presentation Luncheon:

Wednesday 31 October at the conclusion of play: approximately 1.30 pm ~ 2.30 pm at Twin Creeks Golf & Country Club.

(Dress – golfing attire or casual (no jeans)). The cost is \$30.00 per person. Please note that drinks are NOT INCLUDED. Places should be purchased at the time of entry but, subject to numbers, places may still be purchased up until Registration Day.

Registration:

Competitors are required to register between 4:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Sunday 28 October at Twin Creeks Golf & Country Club. At this time, competitors will be required to provide a phone number where they can be contacted during the event. Failure to register may result in disqualification from the Championship.

If it is impossible to register in person, competitors must contact the Championship Office on registration day on 0418 426 613.

Withdrawals:

Please contact Golf Australia immediately on 03 9626 5050 if you are unable to compete. As per condition 10, once a player has been eliminated from the main championship, they are not permitted to withdraw from subsequent rounds unless on the receipt of a medical certificate, or in exceptional circumstances (as determined by the Championship Play Committee). Any player withdrawing from the Championship for a non-approved reason may have their entry into the 2013 Australian Men's Senior Amateur Championship declined.

Results & Draws:

All results and draws will be posted at www.golfaustralia.org.au. The draw for round 1 will be available after 5.00 pm on Sunday 28 October.

Practice Round:

ONE complimentary practice round is available for players after 1.00 pm on Sunday 28 October. Players MUST make a booking with the pro shop on 02 9670 8888 by quoting 'Golf Australia'. Tee times are also available on Sunday from 11.00 am – 1.00 pm however players will be charged \$40.00 for these times.

If players wish to have an additional practice round on Saturday 27 October, this is available for a cost of \$95.00 per person. Tee times are available from 11.00 am and bookings must be made through the pro shop.

Play is primarily from the gold tees and play must be from the daily tee markers only – one ball only. (Competitors in breach of these practice conditions are liable to face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.)

Range Facilities and Balls:

A practice fairway and chipping green are available. Practice balls are available from the pro shop at a cost of \$5.00 per bucket.

Course Guides:

Yardage books/course guides are available from the pro shop for \$5.00.

Distance Measuring Devices:

Distance Measuring Devices are NOT permitted in the Championship Proper. They may be used during the practice round. Penalty: Disqualification.

Motorised Carts:

The cost of a shared golf cart for all Championship Rounds is included in the entry fee and these have been reserved. A cart for the practice round is NOT included. Players must book a cart via the pro shop on 02 9670 8888 if this is required.

Players who would prefer their own cart MUST advise this on the entry form, and an additional charge of \$100.00 will apply. Every effort will be made to ensure all cart requests are accommodated.

Small "motorbike" type carts are NOT permitted.

Caddies:

Caddies will not be supplied. If players require a caddie they must make their own arrangements.

Dress Requirements:

"Hard/Metal" spikes are not permitted. Players, caddies and spectators must adhere to dress which is neat, tidy and appropriate to the game. Denim jeans/shirts, track or leisure pants, and clothing, hats, caps, and visors with excessive slogans or advertising are not permitted.

Catering:

The bistro will be open each day from 10.30 am until approximately 3.00 pm. All food and beverage for players for the duration of the event is at the player's expense (with the exception of the function).

Mobile Phones:

Players must have mobile phones turned off at all times whilst on the golf course during competition play. (Exception: Ringing a Tournament Official for a ruling or any other reasonable cause is permitted).

Golf Australia Hard Card:

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

Course Care:

All clubs which host Golf Australia National Championships kindly give up their course to you for the duration of the event. Hence, so that the course is left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed, players **MUST** carry AND use a sand bucket and repair divots. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.
