2012 WOMEN'S NSW SAND GREENS CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events Run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Championship Procedure

- 1.1 **The Championship** will be stroke play over 36- holes at Cobar Bowling & Golf Club over two days. Day 1 18 holes, Day 2 18 holes. Players are required to play both days.
- 1.2 The winner will be the Women's NSW Sand Greens Champion and will receive the Championship Medal and have their names engraved on the Championship Trophy.
- 1.3 The 2012 Women's RLGA Jug will be played concurrently with the 2012 NSW Sand Greens Championship. Regardless of handicap, players may enter together as a Team Teams of 2 or 3 players, form the same Country District Association or Club, which may enter as many teams as they wish in the event. A player may be nominated in any number of nett teams. In each 18-hole round, the total of the two lowest nett scores of each team each day shall constitute the daily Team Score. The team with the lowest team nett score for the 36-hole event shall be the winner.
- 1.4 The 2012 Women's SWLGA Bowl will be played concurrently with the 2012 NSW Sand Greens Championship. Regardless of handicap, players may enter together as a Team Teams of 2 or 3 players, from the same Country District Association or Club, which may enter as many teams as they wish in the event. A player may be nominated in any number of scratch teams. In each 18-hole round, the total of the two lowest scratch scores of each team each day shall constitute the daily Team Score. The team with the lowest team scratch score for the 36-hole event shall be the winner.
- 1.5 TIES: In the event of a tie in the Sand Greens Championship Salver, Bronze Salver and Bronze Bowl (if played), such players will be declared Joint Winners. Ties in all other events will be determined by the Australian Method of countback..

2. Championship Play Committee

- 2.1 The Championship Play Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Women's Match Committee, Chair of the Golf NSW Men's Match Committee, Golf NSW General Manager Golf, and Golf NSW Chair Rules Committee, or their appointees.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Play Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Play Committee.

Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Play Committee.

4. Entries

4.1 **Handicap**: Eligible players are female amateurs whose Australian Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 45, or who is an exempt player as detailed in Condition 4.5.

No reductions or increases in handicap will be made during the Tournament. Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play.

- 4.2 **Age**: n/a
- 4.3 Entry Fee: the entry fee applicable for this event is \$40 per player. All teams are \$5 per team.
- 4.4 In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, applications from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 **Exemptions**: There are no exemptions for this Championship.
- 4.6 Note: upon withdrawal, as detailed in the Standard Conditions, a \$10 administration fee is deducted (the \$10 admin charge for entries not made online is also non refundable).

5. Motorised Transport

See Golf NSW Standard Conditions. Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission has been granted by the Committee. Applications for permission <u>MUST</u> be made at the time of entry. Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Championship are at the discretion of the host club.

Cobar Bowling & Golf Club - Practice rounds are available on any day, pending availability. Please phone the club 02 6836 2214 to check. Green fees are \$10.

Registration

Competitors MUST register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Perpetual trophies:

DIVISION 1 NSWLGU Sand Greens Championship Salver – 36-hole scratch

DIVISION 2 NSWLGU Bronze Salver – 36-hole scratch

DIVISION 3 Bronze Bowl – 36-hole scratch (if player numbers allow)

TEAMS EVENTS RLGA Jug – 36-hole nett teams

Over the field SWLGA Bowl – 36-hole scratch teams

18-hole scratch and nett prizes will be awarded each day in all divisions. A player may win only one 36-hole trophy and one 18-hole trophy per day, excluding teams and nearest to the pin. Scratch trophies will take precedence over nett trophies. All main events will have scratch and nett winner and runner-up prizes.

10. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.

Note i: Distance Measuring Devices are permitted.

Note ii: The new condition relating to Club Face Grooves will not be in effect until 2014.
