

"B" GRADE ZONE CHAMPIONSHIP MEETING 2012

Conditions of Entry

1. Entries will only be accepted upon payment of entry fee.
2. Late entries will be accepted at the host clubs discretion be accepted.
3. Refunds will be available until entries close.
4. After entries close refunds will only be made at the discretion of the Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group-Women.
5. Lunch, the menu for which is at the discretion of the host club, is provided.

Conditions of Play

1. This event is conducted under the auspices of Golf SA, the Southern Golf Group Women, and under the Rules of the "R & A Golf Club of St. Andrews" and the local rules of the host club.
2. The Executive Committee of the Southern Golf Group-Women will be the arbiter of any disputes or matters arising from the event.
3. Only women members of Golf Clubs affiliated with the Southern Golf Group-women are eligible to enter.
4. Players must have a Golf Australia handicap and be able to verify it if requested.

5. **Handicap limit for this event is 23 - 32**

A player who reduces her handicap below 23 before the first day of play may apply for transfer to the next event . Alternatively, a player who reduces her handicap before the first day of play may continue in the entered event, on her reduced handicap, in the Net event only. The Gross event cannot be won by any player not in the appropriate handicap range.

A player who exceeds the handicap of 32 before the first day of play may remain in the B grade event playing on the handicap limit. (as per Golf SA events)

6. In the event of a tie in any gross event a "sudden death" play-off will take place starting at the first hole.
7. In the event of a tie in a nett event the tie will be determined as follows:
The best score for the last 9 holes on the card shall be used; if there is still a tie the last 6 holes or if still tied the last 3 holes. If a tie still persists then hole by hole from the 18th.
8. 8.1 A player may not win both a gross and nett event.
8.2 The gross event takes precedence over the nett event.
8.3 A player may not win more than one trophy except for the veteran event.
9. To promote participation in this event, motorized transport may be used, without the need for a medical certificate.
10. Play will be in groups of three with the lowest handicap players hitting off first.
11. Players must report to the Starter at least 10 minutes before starting time. If the player arrives at her starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after her starting time in the absence of

circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes at the first hole. Penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is disqualification.

12. Trophies will be presented on the day of play.

13, **In the event of cancellation of play trophies will not be awarded.**

If 9 holes have been completed by the whole field, trophies will be awarded.
