The VANDERFIELD OPEN will be played over 36 holes stroke play at Humpty Doo Golf Club.
Round 1: Saturday 1st September Round 2: Sunday 2nd September

There will be a limit of 112 players.

Entries close 6:00pm Wednesday 29th August. Late entries may be accepted depending on the number of nominations.

Players 55 years of age & over on the date of the competition may nominate to compete in the combined Men's & Ladies Seniors Division, as well as in their grade according to handicap.

Round 1 will not be seeded. Players may nominate their preferred tee off time. This is not guaranteed.

Round 2 will be a seeded draw (best 8 gross scores in men's grades, best 4 gross scores in women's grades).

Seeded players must play in their seeded group to be eligible for the Championship. Persons who are seeded but unable to play at the appointed time will still be eligible for daily prizes but not overall prizes.

The committee reserves the right to vary any conditions of this event.

The draw for each round will be available after 8pm Thursday 30th August & Saturday 1st September on the club website www.humptydoogolfclub.com.au or by phoning the club on 8988 1118.

Eligible players must be a financial member of a recognised affiliated club and must have a Golf Australia or equivalent handicap. **Handicaps will be adjusted for daily events.**

Prizes will be awarded for:

Daily Gross & Nett Winners: Men's A, B & C grades, Ladies A & B grades

Overall Gross & Nett Winners: Men's A, B & C grades, Ladies A & B grades, Seniors Division.

Overall Gross & Nett Runners up: Men's A, B & C grades, Ladies A & B grades

Overall Champion: Men's & Ladies

Daily NTP: Men & Ladies Daily Longest Drive: Men's A, B & C grades, Ladies A & B grades

There is no limit to the number of prizes which may be won by any one person.

In the event of a tie for the overall gross events for all grades, there will be a sudden-death hole by hole playoff until a winner is determined. (holes 17 & 18)

Rule 6-3a will be applied if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play within five minutes of his starting time. The penalty for failure to start on time is 2 strokes instead of disqualification.

There is no restriction on the use of motorised buggies by any player.

SLOW PLAY: Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. 2 STROKE penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
