CONDITIONS

1. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry.
2. Entries to be made to the Honorary Secretary, Croydon Golf Club.
3. The competitions shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, subject to the modification hereafter mentioned, and the local Rules of Croydon Golf Club. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the Match Committee of Croydon Golf Club.
4. Golf clubs must have wooden shafts. Modern balls are permitted
5. The Match Committee is to make all arrangements, and to have full power to alter or to make any variation in the Conditions of Programme should they deem it desirable.
6. The Match Committee or such person as the Match Committee may authorise, may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason, either shorten the contest, or fix another day.
7. In the event of a tie or ties the winner of the Stroke competition shall be a sudden death play-off. In the event of a tie or ties in Events No. 2 and 3, the winner shall be decided on a count-back.
8. The attention of each entrant is directed to the necessity of complete accuracy in their entry form, and any entrant who is misrepresented renders themselves liable to disqualification.
