New Junior Vardon/Derrin conditions for 2013

Jack New ton Junior Golf has announced the new conditions for the 2013 Junior Vardon/Derrin averages on its website. The change of conditions sees the introduction of Open Amateur National Ranking events and Vardon/Derrin competitions contributing tow ards the players averages.

Golf NSW/JNJG High Performance Manager Khan Pullen mentioned "the change in conditions recognises that our elite juniors more and more are playing open amateur events as opposed to junior events." Pullen adds "the conditions are also in line with the changes Golf Australia has introduced to its junior ranking conditions in 2013." Pullen goes onto say that the conditions "also act as a selection guide for our elite and emerging elite juniors."

JNJG recognises that not all juniors are at the elite level so another set of averages know n as the "JNJG Futures" averages which focus just on junior events will also be introduced in 2013. For information on both averages please go to JNJGs Player Rankings and Averages...more

Rules Update



Being the first year of the four year cycle of the new *Rules of Golf* booklet, many clubs have been keen to give their members an opportunity to upgrade their know ledge on the rules and changes to the rules.

This has meant that 2012 has been a very busy year. We have conducted 14 separate Club Level Rules seminars and exams, eight within metropolitan areas and seven in regional areas. These were conducted at: Regional - Dubbo, Canberra, Laurieton, Murw illumbah, Wollongong, Tura Beach and New castle; and Metropolitan - Roseville, Pennant Hills, The Lakes, Cronulla, Wallacia, Elanora, Concord and PGA (Trainees)

Added to this were a number of club rules sessions which included: Tamw orth, Mudgee, Narooma, Mollymook, South West Rocks, Coffs Harbour, Thurgoona, Jerilderie, Merew ether, Belmont & Port Macquarie; Beverly Park, Camden, Liverpool, Monash & Oatlands.

With sessions remaining to be conducted and a number of inspections for course markings and local rules, it highlights what a busy year.

ClubsNSW says pokie law timetable not fair on clubs & pubs



In November ClubsNSW sent out communications about the <u>Gambling reforms legislation</u> which was introduced by the Australian Government. As many Golf Clubs are not members of ClubsNSW

and can be potentially affected by these reforms, we will endeavour to update you on the latest updates about this legislation.

More recently Clubs Australia announced they were supportive of voluntary pre-commitment technology installed on poker machines; how ever felt the Federal Government's proposed timetable does not provide sufficient time for the majority of clubs to comply with the 2016 deadline. Executive Director of Clubs Australia Anthony Ball said the timeline of 4 years is substantially less than that proposed by the Productivity Commission for the roll-out of voluntary pre-commitment. "A fairer method w ould be to require all new poker machines be equipped with voluntary pre-commitment but to allow all remaining machines to be phased out of their natural life cycle...<u>more</u>
