



# Manly Silver and Bronze Salver

Stroke Event

Entry by Nomination

## CONDITIONS OF PLAY

This is an 18 holes stroke event open to all Women players with a current Golf Australia handicap. Silver Salver is open to players on a handicap up to 20 and the Bronze Salver is open to players on handicaps of 21 - 33.

The winner is the player with the lowest gross score. A player may receive trophies for both gross and net.

In the event of a tie both names are to be engraved on the Salver and prize vouchers for 1st and 2nd to be equally divided.

In the event where more than two entrant's tie, the winner will be decided by a sudden death playoff over holes 1, 17 and 18 and the remaining players will be declared joint runners-up.

The handicap trophy is decided on a Golf Australia method of count back.

The use of carts is not permitted unless a current Medical Certificate is supplied at the time of entry into the competition.

The entry fee includes a ball competition. Late entries will only be accepted with Match committee approval.
