MOWBRAY GOLF CLUB INC. Senior Amateur Championship of Tasmania Notes & Conditions

1. ELIGIBILTY.

Eligible players are male amateurs who have reached their 55th birthday on or before 13th February 2013 and who's Australian Handicap does not exceed 27 at the time of entry.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP PROCEDURES.

2.1 The Championship shall be played over 54 holes of stroke-play, 18 holes on Wednesday 13th, 18 holes on Thursday 14th and 18 holes on Friday 15th February, 2013.

2.2 Two Divisions

Division 1 – Handicaps of Scratch - 13 Division 2 – Handicaps of 14 - 27

2.3 <u>Championship Trophies</u> → Overall Gross

3. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE.

- 3.1 The Championship Committee shall comprise of members of the Host Club and one Member of Golf Tasmania.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any such decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.
- 3.3 The Championship Committee decision matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Protests must be in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.
- 3.4 The decision of the Championship Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entry shall be final.

4. RULES OF PLAY.

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.

5. ENTRIES.

- 5.1 Entries shall only be made on the Entry Form issued by the Host Club or a photocopy thereof.
- 5.2 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, and shall sign a declaration, contained in the entry form, to that effect.
- 5.3 Fully completed entry forms together with appropriate entrance fee must be received by the Executive Officer, Mowbray Golf Club Inc., no later than Thursday 31st January 2013.

6. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES.

6.1 A draw for each day's play shall be made and published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Championship Committee as provided in Rule 6-3a.The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of this Championship, that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided by Rule 33-7, if a player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five (5) minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two (2) strokes instead of disqualification.

6.2 The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

7. THE BALL.

- 7.1 It is obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a golf ball which is named in the current Royal and Ancient and/or USGA Conforming Balls List.
- 7.2 Throughout a stipulated round the player is limited to use golf balls with identical markings, except that the player identification number may differ by number only, not by colour. Penalty: two (2) strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round is four (4) strokes.

8. PRACTICE.

After 1.00pm on Monday 11th February and Tuesday 12th February or by arrangement with the Mowbray Golf Club EO.

9. USE OF MOTORIZED VEHICLES.

During a round, competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Committee. <u>Permission will not be given to competitors who do not normally use a vehicle at their Home Club.</u> Please attach Home Club endorsement to entry form. Users of motorised vehicles must conform to the published Mowbray Golf Club Motorised Rules.

10. GPS & OTHER MEASURING DEVICES.

A player may obtain distance information using a device that measures distance only. If during a stipulated round a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

11. DRESS REGULATIONS.

All competitors must conform to the published Mowbray Golf Club Dress Code.

12. TIES.

- 12.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee determines otherwise, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with others, until the winner is determined.
- 12.2 In the event a player cannot be contacted, the Championship will be awarded to the player on the Course.
- 12.3 All other events will be decided by the Australian Count Back System.

13. GOLF AUSTRALIA HARD CARD

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Senior Amateur Championship of Tasmania.

14. CODE OF CONDUCT

All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au

15. NO SMOKING

All competitors and caddies are subject to State Government laws prohibiting the smoking of cigarettes, cigars or the like during the course of any round played in a competition.
