

2013 GOLF SA JUNIOR MASTERS PLAYERS INFORMATION SHEET

Golf South Australia Incorporated and The Royal Adelaide Golf Club extend a warm welcome to all Interstate and South Australian players to the Junior Boys' & Girls' Masters Tournament.

Both events comprise 72 holes of stroke play, 36 holes each day (subject to weather) on Thursday 3rd January and Friday 4th January. A seeded draw will be made for the second day.

Trophy vouchers will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd placegetters in the Boys' Championship and a State Two Man Teams event will be held in conjunction. Gross and Nett trophies will also be provided each day, no player may win more than one trophy (exc. 2 man teams). In the Girls' Championship 1st and 2nd placegetters will be awarded trophy vouchers and a State Two Man Teams event will be held in conjunction along with overall Best Nett and Runner Up.

Dress Rules

<u>Players and caddies</u> are required to comply with the club rules. Neat, tidy dress is essential and shirt must have a collar. No Jeans. Tailored shorts may be worn. If wearing short socks they <u>must be plain white</u> or your club's white socks with logo.

Hire Buggies

Players can hire from club professional & <u>buggies must be returned to the Professional Shop area</u> on completion of round and **not** left at front/ side of clubhouse.

Lunch

Each day on presentation of a lunch voucher at the members' bar area (voucher supplied to each player when they hand in their morning score cards) <u>players</u> will receive a cut roll and piece of fruit free of charge. Any other food and drink must be purchased by the player.

On Course Drinks

Golf SA Official in a motorised cart will provide players with drinks at various intervals, at no charge.

Scorecards

Scorecards will be issued by Golf SA officials on 1st Tee and are to be returned to Golf SA Officials in the Main Bar area of the Clubhouse as soon as possible after completion of your round.

Locker Rooms

The Men's Locker Room is under reconstruction with a temporary change area available for men but no shower facilities. Ladies locker room access will be as normal.

Friday's Draw

A seeded draw will be made for Friday 4th January 2013.
