Conditions of Play

1. Open to male amateurs whose Australian Handicap does not exceed 7.4 (7)
Female amateurs whose Handicap does not exceed 15.4 (15) &
Male Junior amateurs handicap does not exceed 10.4 (10) . Juniors must be under 18 years of age on the day of event.
2. All three events are to be treated as separate events. Players may only enter one event, and this event will be as recorded on the entry form at the time of entry.
3. The entry must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise the entry form will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone without payment by credit card. Late entries will not be accepted.
4. The Fleurieu Golf Course also reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving any explanation . An entrant may withdraw & have their entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the date entries closes.
5. The Fleurieu Golf Course also reserves the right to include members of the Southern Golf Group who have a handicap higher than those listed above.
6. The field for this event will be limited to 72 players in total. In the event of entries exceeding this limit ,a handicap ballot will apply ,with entrants in the Golf S.A. Vardon given priority.
7. Competitors must start at the appointed time . Rule 6-3 will apply.
8. The Match Committee of the Fleurieu Golf Course will make playing arrangements and be the Umpire in the case of a dispute or protest ,which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse no later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play. In the event of a tie in all three events, there will be a sudden death play off.
9. Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced . Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be applied to players in such groups , who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to imposition of penalties.
10. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R&A and/or U.S.G.A. approved lists.
11. Golf SA conditions in relations to Drug Testing and Code of Conduct applies.
12. The use of motorized buggies is not permitted.
13. Players and Caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of the Fleurieu Golf Course.
14. A player may only win one trophy.
15. **HEAT POLICY** : In the interest of player safety, it is recommended that players exercise caution during extreme temperature conditions.
The event may be either cancelled or reduced to 18 Holes, at the discretion of the Match Committee, If the broadcast by the ABC at 7.00 PM on the 16th of February for VICTOR HARBOR is 38 degrees or higher;
JUNIORS: Heat policy is as per Golf S.A. If the forecast is 34 degrees or higher. JUNIOR EVENT WILL BE CANCELLED.
