

Registration form Adelaide Shores Crown Lager Social Golf Club Tournament



First prize is a round for 4 people at the Royal Adelaide Golf Course and a \$200* meal and drinks voucher. Plus there are great monthly random draw prizes to be won.

What does it cost?

There is **no entry fee** for the tournament—you just need to pay the green fee. All players must be members of the Crown Lager Social Golf Club prior to their first round in the tournament and submit this registration form. How does it work?

Play 4 rounds at Adelaide Shores on the Patawalonga course across four months from 1 December 2012 to 31 March 2013. See the Tournament Rules below for further details.

Adelaide Shores Crown Lager Social Golf Club (CLSGC) Tournament Rules:

- This registration form must be completed prior to commencing in the tournament.
- R&A rules of golf will apply combined with local rules as detailed on score card.
- Rounds must be played between 1 December 2012 and 31 March 2013 inclusive.
- Green fee must be paid at the Pro Shop or online (www.adelaideshores.com.au) prior to commencing the round.
- Players must play at least 3 rounds, each in a different month over a 4 month period.
- Where more than 1 round is played by a player in a single month, the best round for that month will be taken as the score for that month.
- Players must tee off from white markers.
- **Scorecards**
 - ◊ Players must advise Pro Shop staff when they are commencing a round for the tournament so appropriate scorecard can be provided.
 - ◊ Players can play at any time but must play with someone to sign off their scorecard who either has a CLSGC membership or Golf Link membership.
 - ◊ Player and scorer both must countersign the scorecard and provide either their Golf Link or CLSGC membership number before lodging the scorecard at the Pro Shop on completion of the round.
 - ◊ A copy of the scorecard will be provided to the player and the player must input the round score online through the CLSGC website for it to be officially recognised for the tournament.
- **Handicaps**
 - ◊ Competition organisers reserve the right to apply a maximum handicap either for future rounds or retrospectively on any player.
 - ◊ Maximum handicap is at the event organisers' total discretion and no correspondence will be entered into.
 - ◊ Players must disclose their formal handicap at the start of the competition if they have one. If they do not have an official handicap, for the first three rounds there will be a maximum handicap of 18 (experienced players must nominate a lower handicap to assist in a fair competition). The 4th round will be based on social handicap produced through CLSGC website.
- Tournament updates and results will be published online.
- The winner will be the player with the lowest aggregate score, after handicap, of their best 3 months' scores.
