**GRADES:**

Grades will be based on official club handicaps. The Secondary School Sport SA Golf committee reserves the right to prepare a draw for all events based on the size of entries. The following groupings provide the basis for the draw.

BOYS:           A GRADE           0 -12 handicap  
                  B GRADE           13 - 18 handicap  
                  C GRADE           19 - 29 handicap  
                  D GRADE           30 – 36 handicap  
(Students without official handicaps will not be accepted)

GIRLS           A GRADE           0 - 25  
                  B GRADE           26+

**NOMINATIONS:**

- 4.1 Nominations are sought from students who wish to compete in these championships and who have **a golfing handicap recognised by AGU or WGU.**
- 4.2 A draw will be sent to schools by Friday 10<sup>th</sup> May and will attempt to accommodate all entries if possible. The draw will be made on the basis of official club handicaps (recognised by Golf Australia).
- 4.3 The School Sport Unit must be notified if a player's official handicap changes – ring 8416 5920 in the week prior to the championship. (The Thursday before will be the cut-off for late handicap changes).  
\* These arrangements are subject to the number of entries received.

**COMPETITION FEE TO BE PAID BY ALL PLAYERS:**

A Grade boys and girls	\$30.00	(inc GST and includes 36 holes)
B Grade boys and girls	\$20.00	(inc GST)
C and D Grade boys	\$20.00	(inc GST)

Entry fee is to be paid to the course supervisor on arrival at the course. If no money is received the student will be ineligible to play.

***Late nomination fee is \$10.00 in addition to the competition fee.***

***Students who do not inform SSSSA of their withdrawal prior to the event will be charged the competition fee.***

**Please note: There is no fee reduction for players who are members of the course at which they are playing.**

**A GRADE BOYS AND GIRLS**

Lunch will need to be purchased individually by the golfers. It is **NOT** included in the green fees as in previous years.

**SUPERVISION:**

***Schools entering more than 4 students at one course are required to provide a supervisor who will remain with the students for the day. This should be an adult who is familiar with the laws and etiquette of golf.***

**STATE TEAM SELECTION.**

**BOYS**

Following the championship, 16 boys will be selected to participate in the PGF Matchplay Series (top 12 qualifiers and 4 other invited players). This series is played in the first week of the July school holidays.

Selection of the interstate team will be based on the following criteria (and not in any order of importance):

- (a) Results from the Stroke championship
- (b) Results from the Matchplay Series
- (c) Attitude and behaviour
- (d) Previous Golfing history

**GIRLS**

This will be the final selection trial for the girls' team. Further information is available in the interstate section of this handbook or on the website.
